

3 DAY BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TODAY AND TONIGHT SATURDAY 20TH APRIL 2024

<u>GENERAL SITUATION</u>: A broad high-pressure system continues to dominate the weather across the Bahamas this weekend.

<u>WARNINGS</u>: Due to persistent arid and warm conditions, the threat of brushfire development remains elevated.

Residents are reminded to remain well-hydrated during outdoor activities and avoid prolonged sun exposure as UV indices are anticipated to be in the very high range on Saturday.

Northwest and Central Bahamas

WEATHER: Partly to mostly sunny, hot, and humid today, fair and mild tonight WINDS: Southeast to south at 5 to 10 knots, falling light and variable tonight in the Northwest Bahamas and easterly at 10 to 15 knots, becoming 10 knots or less tonight in the Central Bahamas SEAS: 1 to 3 feet in the Northwest Bahamas building 2 to 4 feet in the Central Bahamas, seas higher along Atlantic exposures.

<u>Southeast Bahamas</u>

WEATHER: Partly to mostly sunny, hot, and breezy, fair and warm tonight ADVISORY: *Small craft should exercise caution* WINDS:Northeast to east at 15 to 20 knots, falling to 10 to 15 knots tonight SEAS: 4 to 6 feet

EXTENDED FORECAST: The high pressure will begin to lose its grip on the Bahama islands on Monday when a pre-frontal trough enters the extreme northwestern islands followed by a cold front on Monday evening. The front will trek southeastward through the islands by the middle of next week.

FORECAST FOR SUNDAY

WEATHER: Partly to mostly sunny and hot, fair and mild at night

WINDS: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less in the Northwest Islands, east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots in the Central Islands, and easterly at 15 to 20 knots in the Southeast Bahamas **SEAS:** 1 to 3 feet in the Northwest, 2 to 4 feet in the Central, and 4 to 6 feet in the Southeast Bahamas, small craft caution continues

FORECAST FOR MONDAY

WEATHER: Partly cloudy and hot with isolated showers in the Extreme Northwest Bahamas. Mostly sunny, humid, and hot in the remaining islands.

WINDS: South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 knots or less in the Northwest Bahamas and east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots in the Central and Southeast Bahamas

SEAS: 1 to 3 feet in the Northwest Bahamas and 2 to 4 feet in the Central and Southeast Bahamas
