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MARINE FORECAST FOR THE EXTREME NORTHWEST BAHAMAS FOR 24 HOURS 6 PM TUESDAY 23RD APRIL 2024 ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 2300UTC.

SPECIAL WARNINGS: THE PUBLIC IS ADVISED THAT THERE IS HIGH RISK OF RIP CURRENTS AND MODERATE TO STRONG UNDERTOW, DUE TO LARGE SWELLS GENERATED FROM THE LOW THAT IS NORTH OF BERMUDA; EAST OF THE NORTHEAST UNITED STATES SEABOARD.

GENERAL SITUATION: DUE TO A DEEP AREA OF LOW PRESSURE CHURNING IN THE WESTERN ATLANTIC, HAZARDOUS SEAS WILL CONTINUE ACROSS THE AREAS. COASTAL AREAS EXPOSED TO THE SWELLS WILL EXPERIENCE MINOR FLOODING AND POSSIBLE BEACH EROSION.

AREA: (GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI, AND THEIR ADJACENT WATERS)

- ADVISORY:** NONE NEAR SHORE AND IN SHELTHED AREAS... BUT A NOT TO VENTURE OUT OF PORT FOR THE ATLANTIC EXPOSED WATERS...
- WINDS:** NORTHEAST TO EAST 10 TO 15 KNOTS TONIGHT AND TOMORROW.
- LOCAL SEAS:** LESS THAN 2 FEET NEAR SHORE; 2 TO 4 FEET OFF SHORE AND 6 TO 8 FEET FOR THE ATLANTIC EXPOSED WATERS.
- GULF STREAM:** 6 TO 8 FEET
- SWELLS:** MODERATE TO LARGE NORTHERLY SWELLS
- WEATHER:** FAIR AND COMFORTABLY COOL OVERNIGHT BECOMING MOSTLY TO PARTLY SUNNY AND WARM TOMORROW.
