BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST FOR TONIGHT & TOMORROW (ISSUED: 6PM FRIDAY 19TH APRIL, 2024).

GENERAL SITUATION: A ridge of high pressure remains dominant in our area promoting fair weather conditions, gentle to moderate breezes, and slight to moderate seas. This translates to pleasant boating and beaching conditions for mariners and beachgoers.

SPECIAL WARNINGS: There is a marginal risk of rip currents along north and east coast beaches.

Northwest, Central, & Southeast Bahamas

WEATHER: Fair weather conditions.

ADVISORY: A small craft caution is in effect for Atlantic waters in the Central & Southeast Bahamas.

WINDS: In the Northwest Bahamas, southeasterly at 10 knots or less tonight through tomorrow. In the

Central Bahamas, easterly at 10 knots or less tonight increasing to 10-15 knots tomorrow. In the

Southeast Bahamas, northeast to east at 10-15 knots tonight through tomorrow.

SEAS: 1-3 feet nearshore and among sheltered areas but up to 3-5 feet offshore and in Atlantic waters.

SWELL: 3-5 feet in light easterly swells along Atlantic exposures.
