BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST FOR TONIGHT & TOMORROW (ISSUED: 6 PM WEDNESDAY 24TH APRIL, 2024).

<u>GENERAL SITUATION:</u> High pressure centered to the northeast of the island chain will support a stable weather pattern over the northwestern & central islands tonight through tomorrow while the southeast Bahamas experiences spotty shower activity due to an inverted surface trough nearby.

SPECIAL WARNINGS: There is a moderate risk of rip currents along north and east coast beaches. Beachgoers should proceed with caution when entering Atlantic waters.

Northwest Bahamas

WEATHER: Fair weather conditions tonight through tomorrow.

ADVISORY: NONE.

WINDS: northeast to east at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times tonight and overnight

then increasing to 10-15 knots out of the northeast to east by late Thursday morning.

SEAS: 1-3 feet nearshore and among sheltered areas but up to 4-6 feet offshore and in Atlantic waters.

SWELL: 4-6 feet in northeasterly swell.

Central & Southeast Bahamas

WEATHER: Widely scattered showers tonight likely to continue intermittently through tomorrow.

ADVISORY: A small craft caution remains in effect for Atlantic waters tonight through tomorrow.

WINDS: northeast to east at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times tonight and overnight then increasing to 10-15 knots out of the northeast to east by Thursday morning.

SEAS: 1-3 feet nearshore and among sheltered areas but up to 5-7 feet offshore and in Atlantic waters.

SWELL: 5-7 feet in north to northeasterly swell.
