

## **BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST**

## THIS IS A PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND TOMORROW THURSDAY 18<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2024 ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6PM

GENERAL SITUATION: A high pressure system along with gentle to moderate breeze will cover the Bahamas through tomorrow.

WARNINGS: Beach goers and small craft operators should be vigilant due to moderate risk of rip currents and a moderate to large surf, along Atlantic exposed beaches. Due to persistent arid and warm conditions, the threat of brushfire development remains elevated.

## **Northwest Bahamas**

WEATHER: Fair and mild tonight, becoming partly to mostly sunny and hot tomorrow

ADVISORY: Small craft should exercise caution in sea swells

WINDS: East to southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times

**SEAS:** 1 to 3 feet near shore, building 4 to 6 feet in easterly swells over open waters

## **Central and Southeast Bahamas**

**WEATHER**: Fair and mild tonight, becoming partly to mostly sunny and hot with an isolated shower tomorrow

ADVISORY: Small craft advisory continue in sea swells

**WINDS**: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots in the central Bahamas, increasing to 15 knots in the Southeast Bahamas

**SEAS:** 2 to 4 feet in the Central Islands building 3 to 5 feet in the Southeast Bahamas, seas building 5-7 feet in northeast and east sea swells
