## **EXTREME** NORTHWEST BAHAMAS **MARINE FORECAST** FOR 24 HOURS FROM 06:00PM **EDT** FRIDAY, 19<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2024 ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY FREEPORT OFFICE AT 2125UTC (**1725HR**)

**WARNINGS:** ... A MODERATE RISK OF RIP CURRENTS IS IN PLACE FOR THE EAST AND SOUTH COASTS THEREFORE SWIMMERS, BEACHGOERS AND MARINERS ARE URGED TO EXERCISE CAUTION ...

**GENERAL SITUATION:** DEEP-LAYERED RIDGING MAINTAINS CONTROL OF THE WEATHER PATTERN THROUGH THE WEEKEND RESULTING IN DRY, VERY WARM AND STABLE CONDITIONS ACROSS THE FORECAST AREA. SHOWER CHANCES REMAIN VERY LIMITED OVER THE NEXT COUPLE OF DAYS HOWEVER, A SLIGHT INCREASE IN SHOWERS IS EXPECTED LATE MONDAY AND TUESDAY.
