EXTREME NORTHWEST BAHAMAS **MARINE FORECAST** FOR 24 HOURS FROM 06:00PM **EDT** THURSDAY, 18TH APRIL 2024 ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY FREEPORT OFFICE AT 2130UTC (**1730HRS**)

SPECIAL WARNINGS: ... A HIGH RISK OF RIP CURRENTS CONTINUES FOR THE EAST AND SOUTH COASTS (ESPECIALLY ATLANTIC EXPOSURES) THEREFORE MARINERS, SWIMMERS AND BEACHGOERS ARE URGED TO REMAIN VIGILANT ...

GENERAL SITUATION: AN EXPANSIVE HIGH PRESSURE SLIGHTLY NORTH OF THE FORECAST AREA WILL CONTINUE TO DOMINATE THE WEATHER PATTERN AS THE WORKWEEK COMES TO A CLOSE AND THE WEEKEND BEGINS. THE HIGH WILL GRADUALLY SHIFT EASTWARD OVER THE WEEKEND RESULTING IN VEERING WINDS, DRY, AND VERY WARM CONDITIONS.

AREA: EXTREME NORTHWEST BAHAMAS (GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI, AND THEIR ADJACENT WATERS)

ADVISORY: NONE

WINDS: SOUTHEASTERLY 5 TO 10 KNOTS TONIGHT FALLING LIGHT AND VARIABLE AT TIMES BECOMING SOUTHEAST TO SOUTH 5 TO 10 KNOTS FRIDAY BUT FALLING LIGHT AND VARIABLE AT TIMES.
