EXTREME NORTHWEST BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND TOMORROW FRIDAY, 03RD MAY, 2024

WARNINGS: ... A HIGH RISK OF RIP CURRENTS REMAIN IN PLACE FOR EAST COASTAL WATERS (ESPECIALLY ATLANTIC EXPOSURES) THEREFORE, MARINERS, SWIMMERS AND BEACHGOERS ARE URGED TO EXERCISE CAUTION...

GENERAL SITUATION: DEEP-LAYER RIDGING WILL CONTINUE TO DOMINATE THE OVERALL WEATHER PATTERN ACROSS THE FORECAST AREA THROUGH THE WEEKEND. HOWEVER, A WEAK MID TO UPPER-LEVEL TROUGH IS EXPECTED TO MOVE ACROSS THE FORECAST AREA LATER TONIGHT AND INTO SATURDAY RESULTING IN A SLIGHT INCREASE CHANCE OF SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS.

AREA: EXTREME NORTHWEST BAHAMAS (GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI, AND THEIR ADJACENT WATERS)

WEATHER: PARTLY CLOUDY, MILD AND A TAD BREEZY TONIGHT WITH ISOLATED SHOWERS AND A SLIGHT CHANCE OF AN ISOLATED THUNDERSTORM OR TWO. PARTLY SUNNY, SOMEWHAT BREEZY AND QUITE WARM TOMORROW WITH ISOLATED SHOWERS AND A SLIGHT CHANCE OF ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS MAINLY DURING THE LATE MORNING THROUGH AFTERNOON HOURS.

ADVISORY: *GUSTY WINDS, HIGHER SEAS, AND REDUCED VISIBILITY ARE LIKELY NEAR OR IN THUNDERSTORMS OR HEAVY SHOWERS*

WINDS: EASTERLY 15 KNOTS TONIGHT GUSTY AT TIMES BECOMING EAST SOUTHEAST (ESE) 10 TO 15 KNOTS TOMORROW WITH INTERMITTENT GUSTY PERIODS.

LOCAL SEAS: 2 FEET OR LESS OVER SHELTERED NEAR COASTAL WATERS AND 3 TO 5 FEET OVER OPEN AND ATLANTIC EXPOSED WATERS

GULF STREAM: 2 TO 4 FEET
