MARINE FORECAST FOR THE EXTREME NORTHWEST BAHAMAS FOR 24 HOURS 6 PM WEDNESDAY 24TH APRIL 2024 ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 2300UTC.

SPECIAL WARNINGS: THE PUBLIC IS ADVISED OF THE MODERATE RISK OF RIP CURRENTS AND LIGHT TO MODERATE UNDERTOW TONIGHT AND TOMORROW.

GENERAL SITUATION: HIGH PRESSURE WILL BE THE DOMINANT FEATURE FOR THE NEXT SEVERAL DAYS. THE TIGHTENING OF THE PRESSURE WILL CAUSE THE WINDS TO INCREASE AND SEAS TO DETERIORATE FOR THE WEEKEND FORECAST. THE BREEZES WILL BE THE FRESH TO STRONG RANGE AND SHOULD TRIGGER SOME HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS DURING THIS TIME FRAME.
