



**Bahamas Department of Meteorology (Freeport)**  
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**MARINE FORECAST FOR THE EXTREME NORTHWEST BAHAMAS FOR 24 HOURS 6 PM WEDNESDAY 24<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2024 ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 2300UTC.**

**SPECIAL WARNINGS:** THE PUBLIC IS ADVISED OF THE MODERATE RISK OF RIP CURRENTS AND LIGHT TO MODERATE UNDERTOW TONIGHT AND TOMORROW.

**GENERAL SITUATION:** HIGH PRESSURE WILL BE THE DOMINANT FEATURE FOR THE NEXT SEVERAL DAYS. THE TIGHTENING OF THE PRESSURE WILL CAUSE THE WINDS TO INCREASE AND SEAS TO DETERIORATE FOR THE WEEKEND FORECAST. THE BREEZES WILL BE THE FRESH TO STRONG RANGE AND SHOULD TRIGGER SOME HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS DURING THIS TIME FRAME.

**AREA: (GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI, AND THEIR ADJACENT WATERS)**

- ADVISORY:** NONE NEAR SHORE AND IN SHELTERED AREAS... BUT A SMALL CRAFT ADVISORY FOR THE ATLANTIC EXPOSED WATERS...
- WINDS:** EASTERLY 10 TO 15 KNOTS TONIGHT BECOMING NORTHEAST TO EAST TOMORROW.
- LOCAL SEAS:** LESS THAN 2 FEET LOCALLY AND UP TO 5 FEET FOR THE ATLANTIC EXPOSED WATERS.
- GULF STREAM:** 2 TO 3 FEET
- SWELLS:** LIGHT TO MODERATE NORTHEASTERLY SWELLS
- WEATHER:** PARTLY CLOUDY TO FAIR AND COMFORTABLY COOL OVERNIGHT BECOMING MOSTLY TO PARTLY SUNNY AND WARM TOMORROW.
