



**MARINE FORECAST FOR THE EXTREME NORTHWEST BAHAMAS FOR 24 HOURS FROM 12PM TUESDAY APRIL 23, 2024 ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 1545UTC**

**SPECIAL WARNINGS:** THERE IS AN ELEVATED RISK OF RIP CURRENTS FOR AREA WATERS... SWELLS WILL PROPAGATE TOWARD THE NORTHERN AND EASTERN ATLANTIC SHORELINES THROUGH THE LATTER HALF OF THE WORK WEEK...

**GENERAL SITUATION:** A HIGH PRESSURE CENTER WILL ESTABLISH ITSELF NORTH OF THE ISLANDS AND GENERATE MOSTLY STABLE, DRY AND PLEASANT CONDITIONS THROUGH THE REMAINDER OF THE WEEK...

(GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI AND THEIR ADJACENT WATERS)

**ADVISORY:** A SMALL CRAFT ADVISORY IS IN EFFECT FOR THE ATLANTIC AND GULF STREAM WATERS DUE TO SWELLS... SMALL CRAFT SHOULD NOT VENTURE TOO FAR FROM PORT...

**WINDS:** NORTHEAST AT 10 TO 15 KNOTS ON THIS AFTERNOON BECOMING NORTHEAST TO EAST AT 10 KNOTS TONIGHT...

**LOCAL SEAS:** 2 TO 4 FEET LOCALLY AND OVER SHELTERED WATERS AND UP TO 6 FEET IN THE ATLANTIC WATERS TONIGHT... AFTER MIDNIGHT THE ATLANTIC WATERS WILL BUILD UP TO 8 FEET... FOR TUESDAY SEAS WILL BECOME 2 TO 4 FEET LOCALLY AND OVER SHELTERED WATERS AND UP TO 9 FEET IN THE ATLANTIC WATERS...

**GULF STREAM:** 4 TO 6 FEET WITH OCCASIONAL PEAKS TO 8 FEET THIS AFTERNOON THROUGH TONIGHT...

**SWELLS:** MODERATE TO LARGE SWELLS NORTHERLY SWELLS ON THE ATLANTIC WATERS AND FUNNELING INTO THE GULF STREAM...

**WEATHER** CHANCE OF AN ISOLATED SHOWER THIS AFTERNOON...

**ADVISORY:** A SMALL CRAFT ADVISORY IS IN EFFECT FOR THE ATLANTIC AND GULF STREAM WATERS DUE TO SWELLS... SMALL CRAFT SHOULD NOT VENTURE TOO FAR FROM PORT...

**WINDS:** NORTHEAST TO EAST AT 10 TO 15 KNOTS...

**LOCAL SEAS:** 2 TO 4 FEET OVER THE SHELTERED WATERS BUT UP TO 6 FEET ON THE ATLANTIC WATERS...

**GULF STREAM:** 3 TO 5 FEET WITH OCCASIONAL PEAKS TO 6 FEET...

**SWELLS:** LIGHT TO MODERATE SWELLS NORTHEASTERLY SWELLS ON THE ATLANTIC WATERS AND FUNNELING INTO THE NORTHERN PORTIONS OF THE GULF STREAM... SWELLS BECOMING LIGHT TO MODERATE WEDNESDAY NIGHT...
