GENERAL SITUATION: AS RIDGING ACROSS THE AREA WEAKENS A RELATIVELY WEAK COLD FRONT WILL GRADUALLY APPROACH THE ISLANDS... SHOWER CHANCES ARE EXPECTED TO INCREASE AFTER MIDNIGHT TONIGHT... THE FRONTAL BOUNDARY WILL CROSS THE ISLANDS SATURDAY AFTERNOON AND STALL OVER THE FORECAST AREA EARLY SUNDAY MORNING WHERE A LOW IS EXPECTED TO FORM IN THE VICINITY OF BIMINI...
