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EXTREME NORTHWEST BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND TOMORROW, THURSDAY 25TH APRIL 2024.

GENERAL SITUATION: NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THE OVERNIGHT FORECAST AS HIGH PRESSURE CONTINUES TO DOMINATE THE SCENE. THE PRESSURE GRADIENT WILL TIGHTEN FRIDAY, CAUSING THE WINDS TO STRENGTHEN. WITH THE FRESH EASTERLY BREEZES, EXPECT A DECENT AMOUNT OF ATMOSPHERIC MIXING WHICH WILL BUILD CLOUD COVERAGE, TRIGGERING POSSIBLE SPRINKLES FOR THE AREA DURING THE AFTERNOON AND EVENING HOURS.

SPECIAL WARNINGS: THE PUBLIC IS ADVISED OF THE LIGHT RISK OF RIP CURRENTS TONIGHT WHICH WILL INCREASE TOMORROW NIGHT.
