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SEVERE WEATHER WARNING

The Bahamas Department of Meteorology has issued a Severe Thunderstorm Warning valid from 10:30 AM to 12:30 PM, Saturday 6th June 2026.

A Severe Thunderstorm Warning is in effect for Mayaguana along with its adjacent waters.

At 10:25 am, lightning detection, observation, radar, and satellite imagery depicted a cluster of moderate to heavy showers and thunderstorms moving across and towards the warning areas. These showers and thunderstorms are associated with a trough combined with an upper-level disturbance near the warning area.

Some of these showers will be locally heavy and thunderstorms will be strong and severe at times causing strong gusty winds, dangerous lightning, heavy downpours, possible hail, waterspout and/or tornadic activity. Localized flooding is also possible during these storms.

Boaters in the warning areas should seek safe harbor and residents should stay indoors and away from windows when conditions worsen. Residents should not seek shelter under trees or in water as these can become lightning conductors.
