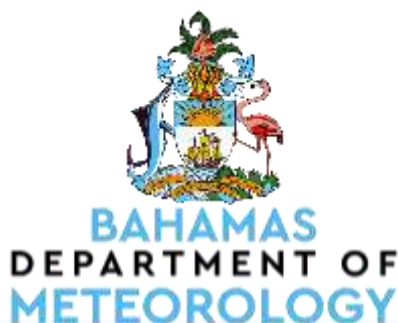

SEVERE WEATHER WARNING



THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY HAS ISSUED A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING ON THURSDAY, AUGUST 6, 2026 FROM 10:50 PM EDT UNTIL 12:00 AM EDT.

A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING IS NOW IN EFFECT FOR CENTRAL AND SOUTH ELEUTHERA (MAINLY TARPUM BAY AND ROCKS SOUND) ALONG WITH THEIR ADJACENT WATERS AND CAYS.

AT 10:59 PM EDT OBSERVATION, RADAR AND SATELLITE IMAGERY DEPICTED CLUSTERS OF MODERATE TO HEAVY SHOWERS AND EMBEDDED THUNDERSTORMS MOVING FROM THE WESTWARDS TOWARDS THE WARNING AREAS. THESE SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS ARE ASSOCIATED WITH AN UPPER LEVEL DISTURBANCE INTERACTING WITH RICH TROPICAL MOISTURE.

SOME OF THESE THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE SEVERE AT TIMES CAUSING STRONG GUSTY WINDS, DANGEROUS LIGHTNING, HEAVY DOWNPOURS, HAIL AND POSSIBLE WATERSPOUT OR TORNADIC ACTIVITY.

BOATERS IN THE WARNING AREA SHOULD SEEK SAFE HARBOUR AND RESIDENTS IN THE WARNING AREA SHOULD STAY INDOORS AND AWAY FROM WINDOWS WHEN CONDITIONS WORSEN. RESIDENTS SHOULD NOT SEEK SHELTER UNDER TREES OR IN WATER AS THESE CAN BECOME LIGHTNING CONDUCTORS.
