BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, MONDAY, JULY 6, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

A Heat Advisory remains in effect for all areas. Due to high temperatures in the mid 90's and UV heat indices in the triple digits (very high to extreme range) All residents and visitors are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen and avoid prolonged sun exposure during peak sunshine hours of 11am to 4pm.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

A Dust Advisory is now in effect for the Central and Southeast Bahamas, as well as the Turks & Caicos Islands. Residents, especially those with respiratory conditions, should take the necessary precautions to safeguard their health.

High pressure ridging across the Bahamas will maintain gentle to moderate breezes over the Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas, while fresh breezes persist across the Southeast Bahamas, along with hot temperatures for all areas. A thick plume of Saharan dust covering the Central and Southeast Bahamas will promote hazy skies, reduced visibility and generally drier conditions. Meanwhile, moisture associated with the northern extent of a tropical wave over the western Caribbean Sea will support isolated showers and thunderstorms, mainly across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas today. By tonight, the Saharan dust plume will spread into the Northwest Bahamas, helping to suppress shower and thunderstorm activity through tonight and into tomorrow.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: Scattered showers and thunderstorms will continue across the Northern Bahamas early Tuesday due to lingering moisture. Conditions will gradually become drier and more stable later in the day as high pressure strengthens and Saharan dust spreads across the archipelago. Through midweek, expect warm temperatures, hazy skies and brisk easterly winds across most of the country. By Thursday, another strong tropical wave is expected to approach the Bahamas, bringing more showers and thunderstorms through Friday. Improving weather conditions are expected by the weekend as high pressure builds back over the area.

Severe Weather Risk: There is a **moderate** risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms particularly across portions of the **Northern & Northwest Bahamas**. **The public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.**

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Flooding: There is a **slight to moderate risk** of localized flooding occurring in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas during heavy rainfall events across portions of the **Northern & Northwest Bahamas**. **The public is urged to exercise caution while traversing these areas.**

Rip Currents: A **moderate** risk of rip currents exists for all waters of the Central and Southeast Bahamas. **Beachgoers are urged to exercise caution when entering the water.**

PRECIPITATION: 10% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing to 15 to 20 knots tonight.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots.
 Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale.

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy tonight.
 Northwest and Central Bahamas: Mostly sunny and hazy, turning mostly fair at night.
 Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny, turning partly cloudy at night.
PRECIPITATION: Northern Bahamas: 20 – 40% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
 Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers.
WINDS: Northern Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
 Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots with higher gusts.
 Central and Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 25 knots with higher gusts.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR THURSDAY 9TH JULY, 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
 Northwest and Central Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy to cloudy by nightfall.
PRECIPITATION: Northern Bahamas: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
 Northwest and Central Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers, increasing to a 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms by the evening hours.
 Southeast Bahamas: 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
WINDS: Northern Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
 Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.
 Central and Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 25 knots with gusts to gale force possible.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

**EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR FRIDAY 10TH JULY, 2026:**

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy at first, becoming partly sunny to sunny by the afternoon hours. Expect mostly fair conditions by nightfall.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:** 40 – 60% chance of showers with thunderstorms, decreasing 20 – 40% by nightfall.

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 20 to 25 knots with gusts to gale force possible.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
84°F – 91°F / 29°C – 33°C 77°F – 81°F / 25°C – 27°C 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Mostly sunny and hazy, turning mostly fair at night.

PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 10 – 30% chance of showers.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 25 knots.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C 77°F – 81°F / 25°C – 27°C 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY 12TH JULY, 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: **All areas:** Mostly sunny and hazy, turning mostly fair at night.

PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 10 – 20% chance of showers.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 15 to 20 knots, decreasing 15 knots by nightfall.
