## **BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST**

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, FRIDAY, JUNE 20, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	There are currently no public warnings in effect at this time.
GENERAL SITUATION:	High pressure ridging continues to affect the weather across the island chain while streaming tropical moisture combined with an upper level low pressure system will increase the chance of shower activity mainly in the Northwest and Central islands through tomorrow.  Outlook: The Bahamas will settle into a typical summertime pattern through to mid-week. Another tropical wave will move into the area, elevating shower and thunderstorm chances across all areas by the end of the week.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Heat/UV Index: The public is advised to remain hydrated, wear loose-fitted clothing and sunscreen while outdoors, and take frequent breaks in the shade as UV indices are expected in the very high range and heat indices are expected to reach the upper 90's to the triple digits.  Thunderstorms: Afternoon thunderstorms may become intense at times, bringing about heavy rainfall that can cause localized flooding.  Funnel Clouds: There is an increased chance of waterspout occurrences, with some that may drift onshore, especially during the afternoon hours. The public is urged to exercise caution.  Rip Currents: There remains a moderate to high risk of rip currents for eastern shorelines of the Southeast Bahamas. Beachgoers are urged to exercise extreme caution in these areas.
