BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

A **Dust Advisory** remains in effect for Northern and Southeast Bahamas through tomorrow morning. Sensitive individuals, including those with respiratory and heart issues, young children and the elderly, should take precautionary measures to safeguard their health.

GENERAL SITUATION:

High pressure ridging over the archipelago will support warm temperatures and gentle to fresh breezes. An upper-level disturbance over the southeastern islands, combined with streaming moisture, will produce isolated showers and thunderstorms, mainly across the Northern and Northwestern islands. The Saharan dust layer has started to thin while moving northward. An area of dust remains over the northern islands and parts of the southeastern islands.

Outlook: By Wednesday, pre-frontal troughing developing ahead of a frontal boundary near the southeastern U.S., along with an upper-level disturbance moving from the south and north, is expected to increase shower and thunderstorm activity across the island chain through the start of the weekend.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Rip Currents: There is a **moderate** risk of rip currents on the eastern and southern coastal waters of the around Inagua and south of the Turks and Caicos Island. *Therefore, swimmers and beachgoers are urged to remain onshore while visiting eastern, southern and Atlantic beaches of these areas. .*

NORTHERN BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: A mix of sun and clouds, becoming mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 20 to 30% chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms, decreasing to 20% tonight.
WINDS: Light and variable at 10 knots or less
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 92°F / 31°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 102°F/ 36°C – 39°C

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny, mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 20 to 30% chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms this afternoon, decreasing to 20% by tonight.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 92°F / 31°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 102°F/ 36°C – 39°C

CENTRAL BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny this afternoon, becoming mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 10 to 20% chance of showers and thunderstorms
WINDS: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F/ 37°C – 40°C

SKY CONDITIONS:	Variably cloudy and hazy, becoming mostly fair tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	20 to 30% chance of showers and thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

PRECIPITATION:	All areas: 20 to 40% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms, Northern Bahamas: East to southeast at less than 10 knots, becoming northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots by the afternoon through evening hours.		
WINDS:	Northwest Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 knots or less, increasing 10 to 15 knots by evening hours. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing to 15 to 20 knots.
