BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, SATURDAY, JUNE 13, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

**WARNING
IN EFFECT:**

*A **Near Gale Watch (winds 28 to 33knots)** will come into effect for the Southeast Bahamas early Monday morning. Boaters are advised to remain in port and beachgoers stay out of the water. There are no public warnings in effect at this time. For additional marine information, please view our Marine Forecast on our website, met.gov.bs.*

High pressure remains the dominant weather feature across the Bahamas, supporting light to moderate winds, hot temperatures, and a few isolated passing showers. Meanwhile, a tropical wave interacting with mid- to upper-level troughing near the Southeastern Bahamas will enhance shower activity across that area through tonight.

**GENERAL
SITUATION:**

Outlook: As the tropical wave moves westward, lingering moisture will gradually spread northward, increasing the likelihood of showers across the northern islands early next week. This moisture is expected to pool ahead of a frontal boundary forecast to approach northern Florida late next week, helping to sustain humid and unsettled weather conditions across the region. Additionally, a tight pressure gradient across the Southeastern Bahamas will support increased winds and rougher seas through midweek.

Heat and UV Index: Members of the public across **The Bahamas** are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high to extreme** range and heat indices may reach the **lower triple digits**.

NOTES:**

Rip Currents: A **slight** risk of rip currents exists along Atlantic-exposed beaches of the island chain. The risk increases to **moderate in the Southeast Bahamas** during the late afternoon and early evening when wind driven waves increase over night. **Beachgoers should exercise caution when entering the water.**

Saharan Dust: There is a **moderate** level of Saharan dust across the **Southeast Bahamas**, and the Turks and Caicos Islands which may impact air quality and hinder visibility. Residents are advised to exercise caution, especially those with respiratory illnesses, should take precautions to safeguard their health.

Coastal Flooding: As a result of the approaching New Moon cycle (Sunday 14th), coastal residents are advised that there is a **marginal risk** of coastal flooding during **evening high tides** through to next week Thursday.

PRECIPITATION: 20 to 30% chance of isolated showers and thunderstorms tonight.
WINDS: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:

1. South-Western Gulf: A broad area of low pressure just offshore of eastern Mexico continues to produce some shower and thunderstorm activity. The system has a low 20% chance of formation through the next 7 days as it is expected to move inland over Mexico by Sunday then later re-emerge into the Northwestern Gulf Tuesday or Wednesday.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY 14TH JUNE 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Mostly sunny, turning mostly fair at night.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy at night.
PRECIPITATION: **All Areas:** 10 to 30% chance of showers or isolated thunderstorms.
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
WINDS: **Central Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, increasing to 15 to 20 knots by the evening hours.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy at night.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to occasionally cloudy.
Northern Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
PRECIPITATION: **Northwest and Central Bahamas:** 30 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms, decreasing 20 to 30% chance by nightfall.
Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 to 15 knots.
Central Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night.
PRECIPITATION: **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:** 20 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 to 15 knots.
Central Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers.

WINDS: Northern Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: Southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
