BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, SUNDAY, JULY 12, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING EFFECT: **A Heat Advisory** is now in effect for the entire Bahamas. Residents and visitors are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing, seek shaded areas and avoid prolonged sun exposure during peak sunshine hours (11am to 4pm).

IN **A Dust Advisory** remains in effect for all islands of the Bahamas, as well as the Turks & Caicos Islands. Residents, especially those with respiratory conditions, should take the necessary precautions to safeguard their health.

A Near Gale Warning (28-33 knots) remains in effect for Inagua and the southern territorial waters of the Southeast Bahamas, including the Windward Passage. Mariners, especially small craft mariners, are advised not to venture too far from port and refrain from entering the southern territorial waters of the islands (south of Inagua and the Turks and Caicos Islands).

GENERAL SITUATION: High pressure ridging along with a blanket of Saharan Dust across the island chain, will continue to produce hazy skies, fresh to moderate breezes, hot temperatures and limited shower activity. Streaming moisture across the Northern islands will support a few isolated passing showers with possible thunderstorms this afternoon into the evening hours.

Outlook: High pressure along with a plume of Saharan dust will remain the dominant weather features throughout much of the upcoming week, bringing hot, hazy, and generally stable conditions across the island chain. These conditions will support above-normal temperatures, reduced air quality, and limited shower activity. By Tuesday into Wednesday, a tropical wave is expected to pass well south of the archipelago. Although it is forecast to remain away from the islands, its associated moisture may be enough to trigger a few passing showers across portions of the country. Temperatures are expected to increase further during the latter part of the week, resulting in hotter conditions.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES: **Rip Currents:** There is a **high** risk of rip currents for the east and southeastern Atlantic coasts of the Central Bahamas, and all area waters of the Southeast Bahamas including the southern territorial waters. **Swimmers are strongly advised to stay on shore.**

Tidal Levels: Due to the approaching **Super New Moon on Tuesday (14th July)**, there will be a **marginal risk** of tidal flooding along coastal and swamp areas, especially during the evening high tide hours starting today and continuing through to midweek.

Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 30% chance of showers, decreasing to a 10% chance of showers by nightfall.
WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Variable at 10 knots or less.
Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots with higher gusts.
