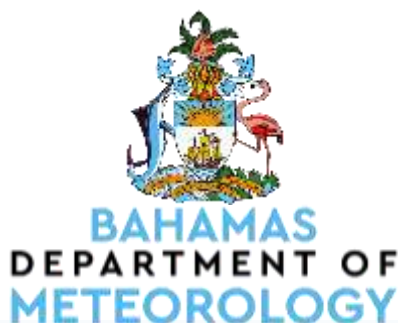

SEVERE WEATHER WARNING



THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY HAS RE-ISSUED A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 7, 2026 FROM 12:00 PM EDT UNTIL 2:00 PM EDT.

A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR THE ISLAND OF NEW PROVIDENCE AND NOW INCLUDES WEST & CENTRAL GRAND BAHAMA, NORTH ANDROS & CENTRAL ANDROS ALONG WITH THEIR ADJACENT WATERS AND CAYS.

A SEVERE WEATHER WATCH REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR THE NORTHERN AND NORTHWEST BAHAMAS ALONG WITH THEIR ADJACENT WATERS AND CAYS.

AT 11:48 AM EDT OBSERVATION, RADAR AND SATELLITE IMAGERY CONTINUED TO DEPICT CLUSTERS OF MODERATE TO HEAVY SHOWERS WITH EMBEDDED THUNDERSTORMS MOVING TOWARDS AND ACROSS THE WARNING AREAS. THESE SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS ARE ASSOCIATED WITH DEEP-LAYERED TROUGHING AHEAD OF AN ACTIVE FRONTAL BOUNDARY NORTH OF THE AREA INTERACTING WITH RICH TROPICAL MOISTURE.

SOME OF THESE THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE SEVERE AT TIMES CAUSING STRONG GUSTY WINDS, DANGEROUS LIGHTNING, HEAVY DOWNPOURS, HAIL AND POSSIBLE WATERSPOUT OR TORNADIC ACTIVITY.

BOATERS IN THE WARNING AREAS SHOULD SEEK SAFE HARBOUR AND RESIDENTS IN THE WARNING AREA SHOULD STAY INDOORS AND AWAY FROM WINDOWS WHEN CONDITIONS WORSEN. RESIDENTS SHOULD NOT SEEK SHELTER UNDER TREES OR IN WATER AS THESE CAN BECOME LIGHTNING CONDUCTORS.
