SEVERE WEATHER WARNING UPDATE

THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY HAS ISSUED A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING UPDATE FROM 12:20 PM EDT UNTIL 2:20 PM EDT, WEDNESDAY 17TH SEPTEMBER 2025.

***A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR GRAND BAHAMA,
ABACO ALONG WITH THEIR ADJACENT WATERS AND CAYS.***

AT 12:15 PM EDT, OBSERVATIONS, RADAR AND SATELLITE IMAGERY CONTINUED TO DISPLAY CLUSTERS OF MODERATE TO HEAVY SHOWERS WITH EMBEDDED THUNDERSTORMS THAT ARE MOVING TOWARDS AND ACROSS THE WARNING AREAS. THESE SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS ARE ASSOCIATED WITH A MID TO UPPER LEVEL DISTURBANCE WEST OF THE AREA INTERACTING WITH TROPICAL MOISTURE.

SOME OF THESE SHOWERS WILL BE HEAVY AND THUNDERSTORMS SEVERE AT TIMES CAUSING STRONG GUSTY WINDS, DANGEROUS LIGHTNING, HEAVY DOWNPOURS, HAIL AND POSSIBLE WATERSPOUT OR TORNADIC ACTIVITY. LOCALIZED FLOODING IS ALSO POSSIBLE DURING THE PASSAGE OF THESE STORMS.

BOATERS IN THE WARNING AREAS SHOULD IMMEDIATELY SEEK SAFE HARBOUR AND RESIDENTS IN THE WARNING AREAS SHOULD REMAIN INDOORS AND AWAY FROM WINDOWS WHEN CONDITIONS WORSEN. RESIDENTS SHOULD NOT SEEK SHELTER UNDER TREES OR IN WATER AS THESE CAN BECOME LIGHTNING CONDUCTORS.
