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SEVERE WEATHER WARNING

The Bahamas Department of Meteorology has issued a Severe Thunderstorm Warning valid from 12:30 PM to 2:30 PM, Monday 1st June 2026.

A Severe Thunderstorm Warning is in effect for Central and South Abaco along with its adjacent waters.

A Severe Thunderstorm watch is in effect for New Providence.

At 12:25 pm, lightning detection, observation, radar, and satellite imagery continued to depict a cluster of moderate to heavy showers and thunderstorms across the warning area. These showers and thunderstorms are associated with a moist unstable air mass and streaming moisture.

Some of these showers will be locally heavy and thunderstorms will be strong and severe at times causing strong gusty winds, dangerous lightning, heavy downpours, possible hail, waterspout and/or tornadic activity. Localized flooding is also possible during these storms.

Boaters in the warning areas should seek safe harbor and residents should stay indoors and away from windows when conditions worsen. Residents should not seek shelter under trees or in water as these can become lightning conductors.
