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### **SEVERE WEATHER WARNING UPDATE**

***THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY HAS ISSUED A SEVERE WEATHER WARNING VALID FROM 12:45 AM TO 3:45 AM, TUESDAY 3<sup>RD</sup> JUNE 2025.***

***A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ABACO, NEW PROVIDENCE AND IS NOW IN EFFECT FOR ELEUTHERA AND EXUMA ALONG WITH ADJACENT WATERS AND CAYS.***

***A SEVERE WEATHER WATCH REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR THE NORTHERN, NORTHWEST AND CENTRAL BAHAMAS UNTIL 6AM, TUESDAY 3<sup>RD</sup> JUNE 2025.***

AT 12:40 AM EDT, LIGHTNING DETECTION, RADAR, AND SATELLITE IMAGERY CONTINUED TO DEPICT CLUSTERS OF MODERATE TO HEAVY SHOWERS WITH EMBEDDED THUNDERSTORMS MOVING EASTWARDS TOWARDS AND ACROSS THE WARNING AREAS. THESE SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS ARE ASSOCIATED WITH A MID TO UPPER-LEVEL TROUGH INTERACTING WITH A MOIST AND UNSTABLE AIRMASS.

SOME OF THESE SHOWERS WILL BE LOCALLY HEAVY AND THUNDERSTORMS STRONG TO SEVERE AT TIMES, **CAUSING STRONG GUSTY WINDS, DANGEROUS LIGHTNING, HEAVY DOWNPOURS, POSSIBLE HAIL, AND POSSIBLE WATERSPOUT OR TORNADIC ACTIVITY.** LOCALIZED FLOODING IS ALSO POSSIBLE DURING THE PASSAGE OF THESE STORMS.

BOATERS IN THE WARNING AREAS SHOULD IMMEDIATELY SEEK SAFE HARBOUR. RESIDENTS IN THE WARNING AREAS SHOULD REMAIN INDOORS AND AWAY FROM WINDOWS AS CONDITIONS WORSEN. RESIDENTS SHOULD NOT SEEK SHELTER UNDER TREES OR IN WATER AS THESE CAN BECOME LIGHTNING CONDUCTORS.
