SPECIAL NEWS ITEM ON ***POST-TROPICAL CYCLONE ARTHUR***, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY FORECAST OFFICE SECTION, AT 12AM, THURSDAY 18TH JUNE 2026.

...ARTHUR DEGENERATES TO A LOW PRESSURE AREA ALONG THE UPPER TEXAS COAST...

...LIFE-THREATENING FLOODING EXPECTED TO CONTINUE ACROSS PORTIONS OF THE SOUTHEASTERN UNITED STATES...

AT **11PM** EDT, THE CENTER OF ***POST-TROPICAL CYCLONE ARTHUR*** WAS LOCATED NEAR **LATITUDE 29.7°NORTH** AND **LONGITUDE 94.5° WEST** OR ABOUT 35 MILES NORTH-NORTHEAST OF GALVESTON, TEXAS.

THE POST-TROPICAL CYCLONE IS **MOVING TOWARD THE NORTHEAST NEAR 9 MILES PER HOUR** AND A NORTHEASTWARD MOTION AT A FASTER FORWARD SPEED IS EXPECTED OVERNIGHT, FOLLOWED BY A TURN TOWARD THE EAST-NORTHEAST ON THURSDAY AND FRIDAY.

MAXIMUM **SUSTAINED WINDS ARE NEAR 35 MILES PER HOUR (MPH)** WITH HIGHER GUSTS. THE REMNANTS OF ARTHUR WILL CONTINUE TO PRODUCE WIDESPREAD HEAVY RAINS ACROSS THE SOUTHEASTERN UNITED STATES DURING THE NEXT FEW DAYS.
