



BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST

MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT FRIDAY, JUNE 05TH, 2026, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

Severe Weather Potential: There is a *moderate* risk of the development of strong storm cells occurring in the vicinity of the frontal trough in the Central Bahamas during the late afternoon and early evening hours. **Mariners are urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology and should prepare to seek safe harbour once conditions worsen.**

WARNINGS:

Funnel Clouds: There is a *marginal* risk of possible waterspout activity in the Central Bahamas, primarily near the frontal trough. **Mariners in these areas are urged to remain vigilant and to exercise caution.**

Rip Currents: There remains a *moderate* risk of rip currents in Atlantic waters of the Bahamas. **Beachgoers and swimmers are urged to exercise caution.**

GENERAL SITUATION:

A weak low-pressure system northeast of the area will maintain elevated seas and a light to moderate chop along Atlantic exposures. Meanwhile, a weakening frontal boundary and weak disturbance near the Central Bahamas will support scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms across the Central and Southeast Bahamas, while drier and more stable conditions prevail across northern waters.

OUTLOOK: Atlantic seas will gradually subside through the Labour Day weekend as the low moves farther into the Central Atlantic. Moisture and a weak disturbance will keep unsettled weather across the Central and Southeast Bahamas, with shower and thunderstorm activity spreading into portions of the Northwest Bahamas by Sunday.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** A *small craft caution* is in effect for Atlantic-exposed waters. *Expect gusty winds and higher seas in or near heavy showers and thunderstorms.*
- WINDS:** Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 2 feet or less nearshore waters, 2 to 4 feet offshore sheltered waters, and 3 to 5 feet, building to 4 to 6 feet in Atlantic-exposed waters tonight.
- GULF STREAM:** Seas 3 to 5 feet, occasionally to 6 feet.
- SWELLS:** Slight northeasterly swells over Atlantic-exposed waters.
- WEATHER:** 10-20% chance of showers.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** A *small craft caution* is in effect for Atlantic-exposed waters. *Expect gusty winds and higher seas in or near heavy showers and thunderstorms.*
- WINDS:** Northeast to east at 15 knots with higher gusts.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 2 feet or less nearshore waters, 2 to 4 feet offshore sheltered waters, and 3 to 5 feet, building to 4 to 6 feet in Atlantic-exposed waters tonight.
- SWELLS:** Slight northeasterly swells over Atlantic-exposed waters.
- WEATHER:** 10-20% chance of showers.



CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** A *small craft caution* is in effect for Atlantic-exposed waters. *Expect gusty winds and higher seas in or near heavy showers and thunderstorms.*
- WINDS:** Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, occasionally falling light and variable at times.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 2 feet or less nearshore waters, 2 to 4 feet offshore sheltered waters, and 4 to 6 feet in Atlantic-exposed waters.
- SWELLS:** Slight northeast to easterly swells over Atlantic-exposed waters.
- WEATHER:** 40-70% chance of scattered showers and thunderstorms.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** A *small craft caution* is in effect for Atlantic-exposed waters. *Expect gusty winds and higher seas in or near heavy showers and thunderstorms.*
- WINDS:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, occasionally falling light and variable at times.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 2 feet or less nearshore waters, 2 to 4 feet offshore sheltered waters, and 4 to 6 feet in Atlantic-exposed waters.
- SWELLS:** Slight northeast to easterly swells over Atlantic-exposed waters.
- WEATHER:** 20-40% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:

Tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next seven (7) days.

**EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SATURDAY, JUNE 06TH, 2026:**

ADVISORY:	All Areas: A <i>small craft caution</i> remains in effect for Atlantic-exposed waters across the island chain.
WINDS:	Northern & Northwest Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts. Central & Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts. All Areas: 2 feet or less nearshore waters, 2 to 4 feet offshore sheltered waters, and 3 to 5 feet in Atlantic-exposed waters.
SEAS:	Gulf Stream: Seas 3 to 4 feet, occasionally to 5 feet.
SWELLS:	All Areas: Slight northeast to easterly swells over Atlantic-exposed waters.
WEATHER:	Northern & Northwest Bahamas: 10-20% chance of showers and thunderstorms. Central & Southeast Bahamas: 30–50% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY, JUNE 07TH, 2026:

ADVISORY:	All Areas: A <i>small craft caution</i> remains in effect for Atlantic-exposed waters across the island chain.
WINDS:	All Areas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, occasionally falling light and variable at times across the Southeast Bahamas. All Areas: 2 feet or less nearshore waters, 2 to 4 feet offshore sheltered waters, and 3 to 5 feet in Atlantic-exposed waters.
SEAS:	Gulf Stream: Seas 2 to 3 feet.
SWELLS:	All Areas: Slight easterly swells over Atlantic-exposed waters.
WEATHER:	Northern Bahamas: 10-20% chance of showers. Northwest, Central & Southeast Bahamas: 20–40% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms.
