



## BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST

MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT SATURDAY, 27<sup>TH</sup> JUNE, 2026, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

**WARNINGS:** **Marine Heat Advisory:** Mariners are advised that **high heat indices** (above 105°F/40.5°C) are expected across the waters of The Bahamas. Prolonged exposure to the sun and hot conditions may increase the risk of heat-related illnesses. *Stay hydrated, limit strenuous activity, seek shade when possible, and monitor crew members for signs of heat stress.*

**GENERAL SITUATION:** Ridging continues to dominate the weather across the archipelago, generating brisk winds and rough seas for the Southeast Bahamas. Saharan dust continues to blanket the Central and Southeastern islands, creating hot and hazy conditions. These conditions are expected to persist through the weekend.

### NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

**ADVISORY:** *None.*  
**WINDS:** Easterly at 10 knots or less.  
**LOCAL SEAS:** 2 feet or less in nearshore and offshore sheltered waters, and 2 to 4 feet in Atlantic-exposed waters.  
**GULF STREAM:** 2 feet or less.  
**SWELLS:** Light easterly swells in Atlantic waters.  
**WEATHER:** Chance of isolated showers.

### NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

**ADVISORY:** There is a **small craft caution** in effect for Atlantic waters.  
**WINDS:** Easterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.  
**LOCAL SEAS:** 2 feet or less in nearshore and offshore sheltered waters, and 3 to 5 feet in Atlantic-exposed waters.  
**SWELLS:** Light easterly swells in Atlantic waters.  
**WEATHER:** Chance of isolated showers.

### CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

**ADVISORY:** There is a **small craft caution** in effect for Atlantic waters.  
**WINDS:** Easterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.  
**LOCAL SEAS:** 3 feet or less nearshore, 2 to 4 feet in open waters and 4 to 6 feet in Atlantic waters.  
**SWELLS:** Light easterly swells in Atlantic waters.  
**WEATHER:** Slight chance of isolated showers.

### SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

**ADVISORY:** There is a **small craft advisory** for Atlantic waters.  
There is a **small craft caution** for open waters.  
**WINDS:** Easterly at 15 to 20 knots.  
**LOCAL SEAS:** 3 feet or less in nearshore waters, 4 to 6 feet in open waters, an 5 to 7 feet in Atlantic waters.  
**SWELLS:** Light easterly swells in Atlantic waters.  
**WEATHER:** Slight chance of isolated showers.

#### TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:

##### 1. Off the southeastern coast of the U. S.:

A low pressure area is expected to form offshore of the southeastern coast of the United States along the western end of a frontal system early next week. *Formation chance through 7 days is low at 20 percent.*

#### EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY, 28<sup>TH</sup> JUNE, 2026:

**ADVISORY:** There is a **small craft advisory** for Atlantic waters for the Southeast Bahamas.

**WINDS:** **Northern Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 knots or less.  
**Elsewhere:** Easterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

**SEAS:** **Southeast Bahamas:** 2 feet or less nearshore, 2 to 4 feet in open waters and 4 to 6 feet in Atlantic-exposed waters.  
**Elsewhere:** 2 feet or less nearshore, 2 to 4 feet in open and Atlantic-exposed waters.

**PRECIPITATION:** **All areas:** Slight chance of isolated showers.

#### EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR MONDAY, 29<sup>TH</sup> JUNE, 2026:

**ADVISORY:** There is a **small craft advisory** for Atlantic waters for the Southeast Bahamas.

**WINDS:** **Northern Bahamas:** Easterly at 10 knots or less.  
**Northwest and Central Bahamas:** Easterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.  
**Southeast Bahamas:** Easterly at 15 to 20 knots.

**SEAS:** **Southeast Bahamas:** 2 feet or less nearshore, 2 to 4 feet in open waters and 4 to 6 feet in Atlantic-exposed waters.  
**Elsewhere:** 2 feet or less in nearshore and offshore sheltered waters, and 2 to 4 feet in Atlantic-exposed waters.

**PRECIPITATION:** **All areas:** Slight chance of isolated showers.

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
