



BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST

MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT SUNDAY, 31ST MAY, 2026, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNINGS: There is a *slight risk* of rip currents across the Atlantic waters of the island chain.

GENERAL SITUATION: The frontal boundary northeast of Abaco is generating enough moisture to keep shower activity enhanced over majority of the island chain. This weather pattern is expected to persist into next week, with majority of unsettled weather remaining across the Northern and Northwest islands.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: *None.*
WINDS: Light and variable this afternoon, becoming southwest at 10 knots or less tonight.
LOCAL SEAS: 3 feet or less in nearshore and open waters, 2 to 4 feet in Atlantic waters.
GULF STREAM: Less than 2 feet.
SWELLS: Light easterly swells in Atlantic waters.
WEATHER: Chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: *None.*
WINDS: Light and variable this afternoon, becoming southwest at 10 knots or less tonight.
LOCAL SEAS: 3 feet or less in nearshore and open waters, 2 to 4 feet in Atlantic waters.
SWELLS: Light easterly swells in Atlantic waters.
WEATHER: Chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: *None.*
WINDS: Northeast to east at 10 knots or less.
LOCAL SEAS: 3 feet or less in nearshore and open waters, 2 to 4 feet in Atlantic waters.
SWELLS: Light easterly swells in Atlantic waters.
WEATHER: Slight chance of isolated showers.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: *None.*
WINDS: Northeast to east at 10 knots or less.
LOCAL SEAS: 3 feet or less in nearshore and open waters, 2 to 4 feet in Atlantic waters.
SWELLS: Light easterly swells in Atlantic waters.
WEATHER: Slight chance of isolated showers.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:

Tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next 7 days.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR MONDAY, 1ST JUNE, 2026:

ADVISORY: There is a *small craft caution* in effect for Atlantic waters of the Northern Bahamas.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** South to southwest at 10 knots or less, veering southwest to west at 10 to 15 knots by the afternoon hours.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.

SEAS: **Northern Bahamas:** 3 feet or less in nearshore and open waters, 4 to 6 feet in Atlantic waters.
Elsewhere: 3 feet or less in nearshore and open waters, 2 to 4 feet in Atlantic waters.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Chance of showers.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Slight chance of isolated showers.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TUESDAY, 2ND JUNE, 2026:

ADVISORY: There is a *small craft caution* in effect for all Atlantic waters.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** West to northwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable by nightfall.
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable by the afternoon hours.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts

SEAS: **Northern Bahamas:** 3 feet or less in nearshore and open waters, 4 to 6 feet in Atlantic waters.
Elsewhere: 3 feet or less in nearshore and open waters, 3 to 5 feet in Atlantic waters.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:** Chance of showers.
Southeast Bahamas: Slight chance of isolated showers.
