MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT TUESDAY, DECEMBER 30TH, 2025, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

Rip Currents: There remains a moderate to high risk for rip currents for all sheltered and

Atlantic waters and channels across the island chain; therefore, beachgoers and swimmers

are urged not to enter these waters.

A cold frontal boundary across the Northern Bahamas is quickly moving into the

Northwest Bahamas, increasing shower activity over the area. Behind the front, moderate winds will bring in cooler temperatures for the remainder of the work

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: Small craft advisory is in effect for the Gulfstream and Atlantic waters.

WINDS: Northwesterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts through tonight.

LOCAL SEAS: 2 feet or less nearshore, 3 to 5 feet in open waters, 5 to 7 feet in Atlantic waters.

GULF STREAM: 5 to 7 feet through tomorrow.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

Small craft caution is in effect for Atlantic waters. ADVISORY: WINDS: Northwesterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts through tonight.

2 feet or less in open water, 2 to 4 feet in the Northeast Providence Channel, 4 to 6 feet in **LOCAL SEAS:**

Atlantic waters.

SWELLS: Light northeasterly swells in Atlantic waters.

WEATHER: Mostly cloudy with the chance of scattered showers.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: Small craft caution is in effect for Atlantic waters.

Westerly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts through tonight WINDS:

2 feet or less in sheltered waters, 3 to 5 feet in sheltered and Atlantic waters. **LOCAL SEAS:**

Light northeasterly swells in Atlantic waters. **SWELLS:**

WEATHER: No significant weather.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: Small craft caution is in effect for Atlantic waters.

WINDS: West to northwest at 10 knots or less through tonight.

2 feet or less in nearshore waters, 2 to 4 feet in open waters, and 3 to 5 feet in Atlantic LOCAL SEAS:

SWELLS: Light to moderate northeasterly swells in Atlantic waters.

WEATHER: No significant weather.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 31ST, 2025:

ADVISORY: Small craft advisory for the Northern Bahamas Atlantic waters.

Small craft caution for the Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas Atlantic waters

Northern & Northwest Bahamas: Northwesterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

WINDS: Central Bahamas: Northwesterly at 10 to 15 knots.

Southeast Bahamas: West to northwest at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

Northern & Northwest Bahamas: 3 feet or less nearshore sheltered waters, 2 to 4 feet offshore

sheltered waters, and 4 to 6 feet in Atlantic-exposed waters.

SEAS: Central & Southeast Bahamas: 3 feet or less nearshore sheltered waters, 2 to 4 feet offshore

sheltered waters, and 3 to 5 feet in Atlantic-exposed waters.

Gulf Stream: Seas 4 to 6 feet, occasionally to 8 feet, subsiding 3 to 4 feet, occasionally to 5 feet

Wednesday night.

PRECIPITATION: Central Bahamas: Chance of scattered showers.

Elsewhere: Slight chance of an isolated shower.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR THURSDAY, JANUARY 1ST, 2026:

ADVISORY: Small craft caution for all Atlantic waters.

WINDS: All areas: Northwesterly at 10 to 15 knots.

All Areas: 3 feet or less nearshore sheltered waters, and 2 to 4 feet in offshore sheltered and 4 to 6

SEAS: feet in Atlantic-exposed waters.

Gulf Stream: Seas 2 to 4 feet, occasionally to 5 feet. Southeast Bahamas: Chance of isolated showers.

PRECIPITATION: Elsewhere: No significant weather.
