



BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST

MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT TUESDAY, 9TH JUNE, 2026, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNINGS: There is a *slight to moderate risk* of rip currents on the Atlantic waters of The Bahamas. *Beachgoers and swimmers visiting beaches in these areas are urged to exercise caution.*

GENERAL SITUATION: Weak troughing across the Southeast Bahamas continues to generate isolated showers over the area. Meanwhile, ridging over the remainder of the archipelago will maintain light to gentle breezes and tranquil seas. Weak ridging is expected to dominate weather conditions across the archipelago until the weekend.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS (INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: *None.*
WINDS: Easterly at 10 knots or less
LOCAL SEAS: 3 feet or less in nearshore, open waters and Atlantic waters.
GULF STREAM: Less than 2 feet.
SWELLS: Light easterly swells in Atlantic waters.
WEATHER: Slight chance of isolated showers.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS (INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: *None.*
WINDS: Northeast to east at 10 knots or less.
LOCAL SEAS: 3 feet or less in nearshore, open waters and Atlantic waters.
SWELLS: Light easterly swells in Atlantic waters.
WEATHER: Slight chance of isolated showers.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS (INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: *None.*
WINDS: Northeast to east at 10 knots or less.
LOCAL SEAS: 3 feet or less in nearshore, open waters and Atlantic waters.
SWELLS: Light easterly swells in Atlantic waters.
WEATHER: Slight chance of isolated showers.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS (INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: *None.*
WINDS: Northeast to east at 10 knots or less.
LOCAL SEAS: 3 feet or less in nearshore, open waters and Atlantic waters.
SWELLS: Light easterly swells in Atlantic waters.
WEATHER: Chance of isolated showers.
