BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

There are currently no public warnings in effect at this time. For additional marine information, please view our Marine forecast on our website, met.gov.bs.

An unsettled weather pattern will continue across the Central and parts of the Southeast Bahamas through tonight, bringing scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms. Elsewhere, generally cloudy and slightly milder conditions will prevail. More stable weather is expected to persist across the remainder of the country as high pressure builds north of the area and a drier air mass continues to move in.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: For the remainder of the Labour Day weekend, ample moisture, the remnants of the front and a weak mid-level disturbance will maintain a wet weather pattern across the Central and Southeast Bahamas, with the dry air mass acting as a buffer for the northern territories for the majority of the period. The disturbance will gradually migrate northwards, possibly increasing shower and thunderstorm chances over portions of the Northwest Bahamas beginning on Sunday. Heading into next week, weak high pressure will gradually build southwards into the Bahamas, catering to patchy cloudiness, shallow topped showers and occasionally brisk breezes.

Severe Weather Potential: There is a *moderate* risk of the development of a few strong to severe thunderstorms over **Central and portions of the Southeast Bahamas** during the late afternoon and early evening hours. *The public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Flooding: There is a *marginal* to *moderate* risk of flooding in the **Central and portions of the Southeast Bahamas** during heavy and prolonged rainfall events. *Residents should monitor conditions and are urged to exercise caution when traversing in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas during such events.*

Rip Currents: There remains a *moderate* risk of rip currents in Atlantic waters of the Bahamas. *Beachgoers and swimmers are urged to exercise caution.*

PRECIPITATION:	Northern Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers. Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 40% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts. Southeast Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times during the day, shifting east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
