BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, FRIDAY, JUNE 12, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

There are no public warnings in effect at this time. For additional marine information, please view our Marine forecast on our website, met.gov.bs.

Weak high pressure will continue to dominate weather conditions across the country, contributing to gentle to moderate breezes and very warm temperatures. Mostly stable conditions are expected though strong daytime heating will trigger a few stray showers with the possibility of a few isolated afternoon thunderstorms across the region.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: Conditions are expected to remain generally stable, as high pressure continues to dominate the weather pattern. However, by Saturday afternoon, a tropical wave moving westward across the Caribbean Sea will introduce locally brisk winds while gradually increasing cloud cover and the likelihood of showers and thunderstorms, particularly across the southern portions of the island chain through the weekend. As the wave progresses westward, lingering moisture will gradually spread northward, bringing an increased chance of showers to the northern islands early in the work week. This moisture is expected to pool ahead of a frontal boundary forecast to approach northern Florida by late next week, helping to maintain humid and unsettled conditions across the region.

Heat and UV Index: Members of the public across **The Bahamas** are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high** range and heat indices may reach the **lower triple digits**.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Rip Currents: A **slight** risk of rip currents exists along Atlantic-exposed beaches of the island chain. *Beachgoers should exercise caution when entering the water.*

Coastal Flooding: As a result of the approaching New Moon cycle (Sunday 14th), coastal residents are advised that there is a **marginal risk** of coastal flooding during **evening high tides** through to next week Thursday.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS (INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly to mostly sunny this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 10 – 30% chance of one or two isolated showers, mainly across Grand Bahama and Abaco this afternoon, decreasing to a 10% chance of showers across the region by tonight.

WINDS: East to southeast at 10 knots or less.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS (INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 20 – 30% chance of one or two isolated showers this afternoon, decreasing to a 10% chance of showers across the region by tonight.

WINDS: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 knots or less.

**CENTRAL BAHAMAS****(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):**

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly to mostly sunny this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 20 – 30% chance of one or two isolated showers with a slight chance of an offshore thunderstorm, decreasing to a 10 - 20% chance of showers across the region by tonight.

WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS**(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):**

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 20 – 30% chance of one or two isolated showers with a slight chance of an offshore thunderstorm, decreasing to a 10 - 20% chance of showers across the region by tonight.

WINDS: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:

There is one (1) area of interest at this time in the Western Gulf. A broad area of low pressure has formed over the far southern Bay of Campeche and is producing disorganized showers and thunderstorms. Environmental conditions are forecast to be only marginally conducive for development before the system moves inland over eastern Mexico late Saturday or Sunday. **Formation chance through 7 days...low...10 percent.**

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SATURDAY 13TH JUNE 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:** Partly sunny to sunny, turning mostly fair at night.
Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny at first, becoming a mix of sun and clouds by the afternoon. Expect partly cloudy conditions by nightfall.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:** 10 – 20% chance of showers.
Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.

WINDS: **Central Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing to 15 knots with higher gusts tonight.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY 14TH JUNE 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern Bahamas:** Mostly sunny, turning mostly fair at night.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy at night.
Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 10 – 30% chance of showers.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northern Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 knots or less, veering southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots by nightfall.

WINDS: **Southeast Bahamas:** Variable at 10 knots, veering east to southeast at 15 knots by the afternoon hours.

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy at night.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to occasionally cloudy.

PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms, decreasing 20 – 30% chance by nightfall.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less.
Central Bahamas: East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 to 15 knots.
Central Bahamas: Southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.

Northwest and Central Bahamas: Southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
