BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, FRIDAY, MARCH 20, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

GENERAL SITUATION:	A stationary front situated across the Central Bahamas will generate scattered showers and a few isolated thunderstorms over that region this afternoon while more stable conditions prevail elsewhere courtesy of a building high pressure ridge and a drier air mass. Expect fresh to occasionally strong breezes across the majority of the island chain and milder temperatures. Outlook: The front will eventually exit the Southeast Bahamas by Saturday morning, allowing a dry air mass and a deep ridging pattern to expand into the region and dominate weather conditions throughout the weekend into next week. The surface high will migrate eastwards from the Gulf of Mexico, allowing winds to relax across the islands by early Monday. A weak frontal boundary may graze the northern Bahamas by mid-week before retreating northwards by Thursday.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Flooding: There remains a moderate risk of localized flooding during heavy or prolonged rainfall over portions of the Central and Southeast Bahamas today. <i>Residents in low-lying, flood prone and urban areas are asked to exercise caution.</i> Rip Currents: There is a moderate to high risk of rip currents for the Atlantic waters of the island chain and the sheltered waters of the Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas . <i>Swimmers in these areas are advised not to enter these waters. Beachgoers in the sheltered areas of the Southeast Bahamas should continue to exercise caution.</i>

SKY CONDITIONS:	Variably cloudy this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	20 - 30% chance of a few light passing showers this afternoon, decreasing to a 10 – 20% chance of an isolated shower or two by this evening through tonight.		
WINDS:	North to northeast at 15 to 25 knots with potential gusts to near gale .

PRECIPITATION:	20% chance of a few isolated showers this afternoon, decreasing to a 10% chance of showers by this evening through tonight.		
WINDS:	North to northeast at 15 to 25 knots with potential gusts to near gale .

SKY CONDITIONS:	Cloudy to overcast.		
PRECIPITATION:	40 – 60% chance of scattered showers this afternoon with a slight chance of a few isolated thunderstorms, decreasing to a 20% chance of showers by late evening. 10% chance of showers tonight through the overnight hours.		
WINDS:	North to northeast at 15 to 25 knots with potential gusts to near gale .

SKY CONDITIONS:	Cloudy to overcast.		
PRECIPITATION:	40 – 50% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms this afternoon through this evening, decreasing to a 20% chance of showers late tonight.		
WINDS:	West-southwest to west-northwest at 10 – 15 knots, shifting northwest to north later tonight.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night. Southeast Bahamas: Cloudy to overcast at first, with gradual clearing throughout the day. Expect partly cloudy conditions by nightfall.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers. Southeast Bahamas: 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms during the day, decreasing 20 – 30% by nightfall.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: North to northeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts, decreasing 10 to 15 knots by nightfall. Central and Southeast Bahamas: North-northwest to north-northeast at 15 to 25 knots with higher gusts.

PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10% chance of showers. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern Bahamas: Southwest to west at 10 knots or less. Northwest Bahamas: Variable at 10 knots or less. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: Mostly sunny, turning fair at night. Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10% chance of showers. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Variable at 10 knots or less. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, increasing 15 to 20 knots by nightfall in the Southeast Bahamas.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern Bahamas: Mostly sunny at first, becoming a mix of sun and clouds by early afternoon. Expect partly cloudy conditions at night. Northwest and Central Bahamas: Mostly sunny, turning mostly fair at night. Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy, turning mostly fair at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 30% chance of showers. Northwest and Central Bahamas: 10% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern Bahamas: Easterly at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times ahead of the front, increasing 15 to 20 knots behind the front. Northwest and Central Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots. Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
