



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, –NIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, FRIDAY, JUNE 26, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

A **Heat Advisory** remains in effect for the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas (inclusive of the islands of **Grand Bahama, Bimini, Abaco and The Berry Islands**). *The public should remain hydrated, limit strenuous outdoor activities and seek shaded areas during peak heat hours.*

**WARNING EFFECT:**

A **Dust Advisory** is now in effect for the **Central and Southeast Bahamas, as well as the Turks & Caicos Islands through to 12pm Saturday**. **Moderate** Saharan dust concentrations will affect the aforementioned areas through today reducing visibility at times and possibly impacting air quality. *Residents, especially those with respiratory conditions, should take the necessary precautions to safeguard their health.*

Occasional pops of moderate to heavy showers and occasionally intense thunderstorms are likely to persist across the northern territories through to the overnight hours, as a tropical wave moving south of the area continues westwards. In the wake of the wave, a thick plume of Saharan dust will reduce visibility and air quality across the Central and Southeast Bahamas throughout the period, as high pressure builds across the Bahamas.

**GENERAL SITUATION:**

**Outlook:** Ridging will persist into the start of the weekend before gradually weakening as high pressure shifts eastward, allowing a weak surface trough to move into the Southeast Bahamas on Sunday. Around the same time, winds across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas are expected to become light to gentle as the pressure pattern relaxes across the area. By Tuesday, troughing tied to a frontal boundary over the southeastern United States will move into the Northern Bahamas, increasing shower and thunderstorm chances before extending into the Northwest Bahamas by Wednesday.

**SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:**

**Severe Weather Potential:** There is a **marginal to moderate** risk of severe thunderstorms (inclusive of heavy showers, gusty winds, hail, funnel clouds and dangerous lightning) during the evening and overnight hours for the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas. *The public is urged to keep updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

**UV Index:** Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high** range.

**SKY CONDITIONS:** **All areas:** Partly sunny to sunny, becoming a mix of sun and clouds during the afternoon hours with mostly fair conditions at night.  
**PRECIPITATION:** **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms.  
**Central and Southeast Bahamas:** 10 to 20% chance of showers or an isolated afternoon thunderstorm.  
**WINDS:** **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing to 10 knots or less across the Northern Bahamas by the afternoon with higher gusts across portions of the Northwest Bahamas.  
**Central and Southeast Bahamas:** East-northeast to east-southeast at 15 to 20 knots, decreasing to 10 to 15 knots across the Central Bahamas.

**SKY CONDITIONS:** **All areas:** Partly sunny to sunny, turning mostly fair at night.  
**Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 10 to 30% chance of showers with possible afternoon to evening thunderstorms  
**PRECIPITATION:** **Central Bahamas:** 10 to 20% chance of showers or an isolated afternoon thunderstorm.  
**Southeast Bahamas:** 10 to 20% chance of showers or an isolated thunderstorm, increasing to 10 to 30% chance by the evening hours  
**Northern Bahamas:** East to southeast at less than 10 knots, falling light and variable by the afternoon.  
**WINDS:** **Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.  
**Central and Southeast Bahamas:** East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots, decreasing to 10 to 15 knots by the afternoon hours, with higher gusts across portions of the Southeast Bahamas.

**WINDS:** **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 knots or less  
**Central Bahamas:** East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots.  
**Southeast Bahamas:** East-northeast to east-southeast at 15 to 20 knots

Elsewhere: A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy at night.

**PRECIPITATION:** Northern Bahamas: 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.  
Elsewhere: 20 to 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.

**WINDS:** Northern Bahamas: Southeast to south at less than 10 knots, becoming east to southeast at less than 10 knots by the evening hours.  
Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less  
Central Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, becoming east-northeast to east-southeast at 10 knots or less by the evening hours.  
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts

Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers or an isolated thunderstorms

**WINDS:** Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, becoming light and variable during the afternoon hours and east-northeast to east-southeast at less than 10 knots by the evening.  
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts across the Southeast Bahamas.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers or an isolated thunderstorm.

**WINDS:** Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Variable at less than 10 knots.  
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts across the Southeast Bahamas
