BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, FRIDAY, MAY 29, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

Deep-layer moisture moving into the Northern islands from the west, together with troughing across area, will maintain cloudy skies as well as showers and possible isolated thunderstorms across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas this afternoon through tonight. Meanwhile, weak troughing across the Southeast Bahamas will continue to generate isolated shower activity across portions of that region. Gentle to moderate breezes are expected across the island chain through Saturday.

GENERAL SITUATION: *Outlook:* High pressure will continue to shift east of the area, while troughing and tropical moisture from the Western Caribbean Sea and Gulf move into the Northern and Northwest Bahamas over the weekend and into the start of the work week. By Sunday, most of the shower activity is expected across the Northern and Northwestern islands, gradually spreading into portions of the Central Bahamas by Monday. Some showers and thunderstorms may become heavy to severe at times

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES: **Heat and UV Index:** On Friday, residents across **The Central and Southeast Bahamas** are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 3pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high** range and heat indices can reach the **triple digits**

NORTHERN BAHAMAS (INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy through tonight
PRECIPITATION: 30 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms
WINDS: South to southwest at 10 knots or less this afternoon, becoming variable at 10 knots or less this evening.

WINDS: South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 knots or less through tonight.

WINDS: East to southeast at 10 knots or less this afternoon through tonight.

**SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS****(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):****SKY CONDITIONS:** A mix of sun and clouds, becoming partly cloudy tonight.**PRECIPITATION:** 10 to 20% chance of showers.**WINDS:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots this afternoon, becoming east-northeast to east-southeast 10 to 15 knots this evening.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: *Tropical cyclone formation is not expected through the next (7) seven days.***EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SATURDAY 30TH MAY, 2026:**

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy with overcast periods
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy, becoming cloudy to mostly cloudy main across the Central Bahamas by late afternoon through evening hours.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 to 50% chance of widely scattered showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers with the chance of isolated thunderstorms in the Central Bahamas.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southwest to west at 10 to 15 knots with occasionally higher gusts, falling to 10 knots or less by the evening.
Central Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less, becoming light and variable by evening hours. **Southeast Bahamas:** Southerly at 10 to 15 knots.

SKY CONDITIONS: **All Areas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms, decreasing to 20 to 30% by the late afternoon hours.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** West to northwest at 10 to 15 knots, falling to 10 knots or less
Northwest Bahamas: West to northwest at 10 knots or less. Falling light and variable by evening hours.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Light and variable.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** West to southwest at 10 to 15 knots, with higher gusts
Elsewhere: Variable at 10 knots or less.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Elsewhere: Variable at 10 knots or less.
