BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, FRIDAY, JULY 3, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

Heat Advisory: A heat advisory is in effect for all areas of the Bahamas due to high temperatures in the mid 90's and UV heat indices in the triple digits (very high to extreme range) All residents and visitors are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen and avoid prolonged sun exposure during peak sunshine hours of 11am to 4pm.

A weak remnant trough across the Northern Bahamas will gradually lift towards the northwest and away from the islands today. Meanwhile, a high pressure ridge remains across the country. Hot, humid conditions, gentle to moderate winds and slight to moderate seas along with quick passing showers and isolated thunderstorms are expected throughout the archipelago.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: On Saturday, weak high pressure will become established east of the archipelago steering Atlantic moisture associated with a decaying frontal boundary across the area. This pattern will maintain an elevated chance for showers over the Northern & Northwest Bahamas through the weekend. Meanwhile, another surge of Saharan dust will spread into the southern half of the country to conclude the weekend. Once again, the dust will aid in reducing shower coverage across the Southeast & portions of the Central Bahamas as it lingers into the upcoming week. Winds will remain gentle to moderate throughout the next couple of days increasing moderate to fresh by the start of next week.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Rip Currents: A slight to moderate risk of rip currents exists along Atlantic-exposed coastlines tonight and through the next several days. Beachgoers are urged to exercise caution when entering the water.
