



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, MONDAY, JUNE 15, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

### WARNING IN EFFECT:

*A Heat Advisory is now in effect for the Northern and Northwest Bahamas (inclusive of the islands of New Providence, Grand Bahama, Bimini, Abaco, The Berry Islands, Andros and Bimini.) The public should remain hydrated, limit strenuous outdoor activities and seek shaded areas during peak heat hours.*

Lingering moisture pooling over the region, coupled with daytime heating, will support pops of showers and thunderstorms mainly across the northern territories during the afternoon and evening hours. A deep ridging pattern will establish itself across the Central and Southeast Bahamas, promoting warm, stable and locally breezy conditions through tonight.

### GENERAL SITUATION:

**Outlook:** The country will remain on the western edge of a broad Atlantic ridge which will support hot, humid conditions and moderate to locally fresh breezes throughout the work week. Additionally, expect strong daytime heating to trigger spotty showers along with a few localized afternoon thunderstorms across the archipelago.

**Severe Weather Potential:** There is a *slight* risk of the development of a few strong to severe storm cells over portions of the **Northern & Northwest Bahamas** today. *The public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

### SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

**UV Index:** Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the *very high* range.

**Rip Currents:** A *slight* to *moderate* risk of rip currents exists along Atlantic-exposed beaches of the island chain. *Beachgoers, particularly those in the Southeast Bahamas, should exercise caution when entering the water.*

**Coastal Flooding:** Coastal residents are advised that there is a *marginal risk* of coastal flooding during **evening high tides** through to Thursday.

### NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

**SKY CONDITIONS:** A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy tonight.  
**PRECIPITATION:** 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms this afternoon, decreasing 20 – 30% by tonight.  
**WINDS:** South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots.  
**TEMPERATURES:** **MAXIMUM:** 90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C      **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 81°F / 25°C – 27°C      **HEAT INDEX:** 102°F – 108°F / 39°C – 42°C

### NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

**SKY CONDITIONS:** A mix of sun and clouds this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.  
**PRECIPITATION:** 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.  
**WINDS:** South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.  
**TEMPERATURES:** **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C      **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C      **HEAT INDEX:** 100°F – 106°F / 38°C – 41°C

### CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

**SKY CONDITIONS:** Partly sunny, turning mostly fair tonight.  
**PRECIPITATION:** 10 – 30% chance of showers with afternoon thunderstorms.  
**WINDS:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.  
**TEMPERATURES:** **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C      **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C      **HEAT INDEX:** 100°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C

**SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS****(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):****SKY CONDITIONS:** Mostly sunny and slightly hazy this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.**PRECIPITATION:** 10 – 20% chance of showers.**WINDS:** East to southeast at 15 to 25 knots, decreasing 15 to 20 knots tonight.

**TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:**

**There is one (1) area of interest in the Northwestern Gulf of Mexico:** A trough of low pressure located over northeastern Mexico has a **low, or 20 percent of development within the next 48 hours, and a low, or 30 percent chance of tropical cyclone formation within the next seven (7) days**, as the system possibly re-emerges over the Northwestern Gulf of Mexico by late Tuesday or Wednesday.

**EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TUESDAY, 16<sup>TH</sup> JUNE, 2026:**

**SKY CONDITIONS:** **Northern Bahamas:** Mostly cloudy to overcast.  
**Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy.  
**Elsewhere:** A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night.

**PRECIPITATION:** **Northern Bahamas:** 30 – 40% chance of widely scattered showers with isolated thunderstorms.  
**Northwest & Central Bahamas:** 20 – 30% chance of isolated showers with possible afternoon thunderstorms.  
**Southeast Bahamas:** 10 – 20% chance of showers.

**WINDS:** **Northern & Northwest Bahamas:** South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the evening hours.  
**Central Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.  
**Southeast Bahamas:** East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.

**PRECIPITATION:** **All Areas:** 20 – 30% chance of showers and possible afternoon thunderstorms.

**WINDS:** **Northern & Northwest Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots.  
**Central Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.  
**Southeast Bahamas:** East to southeast at 15 knots.

**WINDS:** **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.  
**Central and Southeast Bahamas:** East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

**Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas:** 20 – 30% chance of isolated showers.**WINDS:** **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** South to southwest at 10 knots or less.  
**Central Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts, decreasing to 10 to 15 knots.  
**Southeast Bahamas:** Southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.**TEMPERATURES:****MAXIMUM:**
