



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

**BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, –NIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, MONDAY, JUNE 22, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.**

<b>WARNING IN EFFECT:</b>	<p>A <b>Heat Advisory</b> remains in effect for the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas (inclusive of the islands of Grand Bahama, Bimini, Abaco and The Berry Islands). The public should remain hydrated, limit strenuous outdoor activities and seek shaded areas during peak heat hours.</p> <p>A <b>Dust Advisory</b> is now in effect for the Central and Southeast Bahamas, as well as the Turks &amp; Caicos Islands. <b>Moderate</b> Saharan dust concentrations are affecting the aforementioned areas, reducing visibility and impacting air quality. Residents, especially those with respiratory conditions, should take the necessary precautions to safeguard their health.</p>
<b>GENERAL SITUATION:</b>	<p>High pressure ridging will continue to influence conditions across the island chain through tonight, though lingering moisture could spark a few showers and isolated thunderstorms to the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas this afternoon. Meanwhile, Saharan dust across the Central and Southeastern islands will make for hazy conditions, while limiting shower chances before the dust plume shifts into the Northwest Bahamas overnight. Fresh to strong breezes will prevail in the Southeast Bahamas and parts of the Central Bahamas, while gentle to moderate breezes continue across the remainder of the country.</p> <p><b>Outlook:</b> Over the next few days, expect slight to moderate seas across the chain of islands along with moderate to fresh breezes. Winds may occasionally gust strong across portions of the Southeast Bahamas by late Monday into Tuesday. Weak troughing and tropical moisture will persist over the Northern Bahamas through Tuesday, keeping showers and thunderstorms in the forecast for those islands. Over the remainder of the country, a secondary plume of Saharan dust and broad ridging will dominate, acting to suppress rainfall and convective activity while maintaining very warm temperatures. By Thursday, increasing troughing over the northern islands is expected to raise shower and thunderstorm chances once again on Friday into Saturday.</p>
<b>SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:</b>	<p><b>Rip Currents:</b> There is a <b>slight to moderate</b> risk of rip currents along Atlantic-exposed beaches of the archipelago. <b>Beachgoers are urged to exercise caution.</b></p> <p><b>UV Index:</b> Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (<b>10am – 4pm</b>), as UV indices are expected to be in the <b>very high to extreme</b> range.</p>

<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	A mix of sun and clouds this afternoon, becoming variably cloudy overnight.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms through tonight		
<b>WINDS:</b>	Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, increasing to 10 to 15 knots overnight.		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS (INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):			
<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	A mix of sun and clouds this afternoon becoming progressively hazy by this evening, becoming mostly fair overnight		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	20% chance of showers and isolated showers this afternoon, decreasing to a 10% chance overnight.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots.		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>

<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	10% chance of showers through tonight.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots this afternoon, increasing to 15 to 20 knots overnight.		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>
	88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C	73°F – 79°F / 23°C – 26°C	98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS (INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):			
<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	Partly sunny and hazy this afternoon, becoming mostly fair at night.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	10% chance of showers during the early afternoon hours increasing to 10 to 20% chance with possible isolated thunderstorms by this evening through tonight.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>
