BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, MONDAY, APRIL 6, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>A broad area of low pressure will remain across the region this afternoon, with moisture streaming across the area supporting a few passing showers. Overnight, pre-frontal troughing ahead of an approaching frontal boundary will lead to increased shower and isolated thunderstorm activity across the Northern Bahamas and portions of the Northwest Bahamas through Tuesday. Winds are expected to remain gentle to moderate throughout the day.</p> <p>Outlook: Winds across the island chain will continue to subside through Tuesday, with the low pressure area maintaining pockets of showers across the Bahamas. By Tuesday afternoon, the frontal boundary is expected to enter the Northern Bahamas, producing another wave of heavy showers, possible severe thunderstorms and strong to near gale force breezes over the northern territories into mid-week. The front is anticipated to weaken and meander across the area, with strong high pressure building in its wake beginning on Saturday.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<i>Rip Currents/Rough Surf: There is a high risk of rip currents for all east-facing coastal waters of the island chain. Swimmers are advised not to enter the waters.</i>

SKY CONDITIONS:	Partly sunny to sunny this afternoon, becoming mostly fair during the early night hours with increasing cloud cover overnight.		
PRECIPITATION:	10 to 20% chance of showers this afternoon, increasing to 20 to 30% with possible thunderstorms overnight.		
WINDS:	East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny, turning mostly fair at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers during the morning hours increasing to 40 to 50% chance by afternoon along the frontal boundary. <i>Elsewhere:</i> 10 to 20% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times, becoming southwest to west at less than 10 knots during the afternoon hours and becoming northwest to north at 10 knots by the evening hours, and north to northeast at 15 to 20 knots, with higher gusts behind the front overnight. Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less during the morning hours, becoming south to southwest at 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours, and variable at less than 10 knots by the evening hours. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Southwest to west at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable overnight.

PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 to 40% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20% chance of showers during the morning hours increasing to 20 to 30% chance of by the evening hours.		
WINDS:	Northern Bahamas: Northeasterly at 15 to 25 knots increasing to 20 to 30 knots with <i>gusts up to near gale force</i> Northwest Bahamas: Variable at less than 10 knots during the day, becoming northeasterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts. by late evening Central and Southeast Bahamas: Southwest to west at 10 knots or less, veering west to northwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times
