## **BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST**

## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, MONDAY, JULY 14, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	There are no public warnings in effect at this time.
GENERAL SITUATION:	<ul> <li>Weather conditions will remain unsettled this afternoon through tonight across the Northern &amp; Northwest Bahamas as a multi-layered trough and a moist, unstable air mass continues to interact triggering showers and thunderstorms across those areas. Meanwhile, the Central &amp; Southeast Bahamas enjoys much more pleasant conditions, occasionally interrupted by the odd shower or two as high pressure and drier air remains dominant at the surface.</li> <li><b>Outlook</b>: The trough and associated weather across the Northern Islands will gradually drift westward and away from the Islands through Tuesday. On Wednesday, a tropical wave will pass south of the Southeast Bahamas generating shower activity across those islands while moisture and weak troughing lingers over the northern islands through Thursday. The pressure gradient will strengthen over the country, most notably resulting in fresh to occasionally strong breezes in Southeast through early Friday. Meanwhile high pressure building westward over</li> </ul>
	the area will maintain moderate to fresh winds over the remainder of the country through the upcoming week.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Severe Thunderstorm Potential: Instances of heavy rainfall, severe thunderstorms and other hazards, such as tornadic/waterspout activity, hail and gusty winds, may occur in isolated instances in the Northern Bahamas. All residents are urged to remain vigilant of the current weather conditions and to keep updated on all severe thunderstorm warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology. Flooding: There is an elevated risk of flooding across all areas during heavy and prolonged rainfall events, especially the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas through to Tuesday. Low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas are particularly at risk.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:	Northeastern Gulf: An area of low pressure located offshore the east coast of Florida is producing disorganized showers and thunderstorms this morning. This disturbance is forecast to move westward across Florida during the next day or so, and into the northeastern Gulf by late Tuesday. Environmental conditions appear favorable and some gradual development of this system is possible while it moves westward to west- northwestward across the northeastern and north-central portions of the Gulf during the middle to latter part of this week. Regardless of development, heavy rainfall could produce localized flash flooding over portions of Florida and the north-central Gulf coast through the middle to latter portion of this week. * Formation chance through 48 hourslow10 percent. * Formation chance through 7 dayslow30 percent.
