BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, NIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, MONDAY, MARCH 23, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EST.

GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>A broad ridge of high pressure is currently drifting eastward across the country, as dry and stable condition dominates weather conditions for the islands throughout the day.</p> <p>Outlook: Stable weather conditions will persist through midweek, supported by a dominant high-pressure ridge. By Wednesday, a weak frontal boundary is forecast to stall just north of the area, leading to increased cloud cover across the Northern Bahamas and the chance of a few isolated showers. Meanwhile, weak low-level troughing, combined with an influx of moisture, will contribute to enhanced shower activity across the Central and Southeastern Bahamas beginning Wednesday through the end of the workweek.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p>UV Index: Due to the UV index being in the high range, <i>the public is urged to wear sunglasses, sun screen, wide brimmed hats and suitable clothing in the event of prolonged exposure during peak daylight hours (10am – 3pm).</i></p> <p>Rip Currents: There remains a moderate to high risk of rip currents for the Atlantic waters and nearshore areas of the Central and Southeast Bahamas. <i>Swimmers in these areas are urged to remain onshore.</i> There exists a slight to moderate risk of rip currents along all Atlantic exposures of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. <i>Beachgoers in these areas should continue to exercise caution.</i></p>

	Southeast Bahamas: Northeast at 10 to 15 knots increasing 15 to 20 knots by midday. Winds are expected to increase 20 to 25 knots by nightfall.
