



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

**BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, NIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, MONDAY, MARCH 30, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EST.**

<b>WARNING IN EFFECT:</b>	<p><i>A <b>Near Gale Warning (28 – 33 knots)</b> remains in effect for the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. A <b>Gale Warning (34 – 40 knots)</b> is in effect for the Central and Southeast Bahamas. <b>GENERAL SITUATION:</b>	<p>A stationary front across the Northwest Bahamas will move into the Central Bahamas later today. Winds gusting to near gale and gale force, rough seas and scattered showers is being experienced throughout the archipelago through tonight.</p> <p><i><b>Outlook:</b> Fresh to strong breezes, with occasional gusts approaching near gale force and rough seas, especially along Atlantic coastlines, will persist through much of the upcoming week. The frontal boundary is expected to dissipate near the southeastern islands on Tuesday, when a strong high pressure will become the dominant weather feature. Meanwhile, Atlantic moisture, and a tight pressure gradient supporting a brisk wind flow, will support occasional showers across the archipelago throughout the work week.</i></p>
<b>SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:</b>	<p><i><b>Coastal Flooding and Over-topping Waves:</b> There is a <b>moderate to high</b> risk of overtopping waves along seawalls and coastal roads along Atlantic-exposed shorelines, <b>especially the Glass Window Bridge</b> on the island of Eleuthera. A marginal risk of coastal flooding is expected across all other northern and eastern-facing coastal roadways. <i><b>Motorists and residents are urged to exercise extreme caution while traversing these areas.</b></i></i></p> <p><i><b>Rip Currents:</b> Rough surf conditions and dangerous rip currents will plague the area waters of the island chain. These conditions are expected to continue until mid-week. <b>Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly advised to avoid entering the waters.</b></i></p>
