BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, MONDAY, MARCH 9, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	<p><i>There are no public warnings in effect at this time. A Near Gale Warning (28 – 33 knots) remains in effect for the waters south of Inagua (Windward Passage). For additional marine information, please view our Marine forecast on our website, met.gov.bs.</i></p>
GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>A mid to upper level disturbance continues to support bouts of showers and thunderstorms over portions of the Central and Southeast Bahamas. Meanwhile, moderate to locally fresh winds will continue across the archipelago courtesy of high pressure ridging.</p> <p>Outlook: These showers and thunderstorms will gradually move out of the area by Tuesday night as this feature moves eastward. The remainder of the work week will experience mostly stable and warmer than usual conditions, as deep ridging dominates. The surface ridge will weaken further by Thursday, as a cold front moves into the Bahamas by late Thursday night/early Friday morning. The front is expected to weaken across the Northern Bahamas and drift northeastward. The high pressure will reclaim its position over the islands by the weekend.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p>Severe Thunderstorm Potential: Thunderstorms in the Southeast Bahamas may become strong-to-severe at times, with the possibility of waterspout activity. <i>The public is urged to remain updated on any severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.</i></p> <p>Flooding: There is a marginal risk of flooding, mainly in low-lying and flood-prone areas, across portions of the Central and Southeast Bahamas. <i>The public is urged to exercise caution in these areas, especially during heavy and prolonged rainfall events.</i></p> <p>Rip Currents: There remains a moderate to high risk of rip currents for the Atlantic waters and all east and southeast coastal waters of the island chain. <i>Swimmers in these areas are urged to remain nearshore.</i></p>

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy. Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning fair to partly cloudy at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern Bahamas: 20 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms, mainly in the vicinity of the front. Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Variable at 10 knots or less ahead of the front, veering northeast to east at 15 knots with higher gusts behind the front during the morning hours. Expect winds to shift easterly at 10 to 15 knots by the afternoon hours. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing 15 to 20 knots by nightfall in the Southeast Bahamas.
