BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, –NIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, SATURDAY, JULY 11, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

A Dust Advisory remains in effect for all islands of the Bahamas, as well as the Turks & Caicos Islands. Residents, especially those with respiratory conditions, should take the necessary precautions to safeguard their health.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

A Near Gale Warning (28-33 knots) remains in effect for the Southeast Bahamas until 6am Sunday. Boaters, especially small craft operators, are advised to seek safe harbour and remain in port. For additional marine information, please view our Marine Forecast on our website, met.gov.bs.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Lingering moisture, enhanced by an upper-level disturbance, will support periods of cloudiness and the chance of an isolated shower or two across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas this afternoon into the evening hours. Meanwhile, another plume of Saharan dust moving through the Southern and Central Bahamas will promote more stable and hazy conditions this afternoon before spreading into the Northwest Bahamas overnight into Sunday. Breezes will vary from gentle to moderate across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas to fresh to strong across the Central and Southeastern islands, with near-gale gusts possible near Inagua.

Outlook: A strong high-pressure ridge will rebuild across the archipelago this weekend and into early next week, bringing breezy, hot, and generally stable weather conditions. Lingering Saharan dust will maintain hazy skies and help limit shower and thunderstorm development.

Rip Currents: Swimmers and beachgoers *in the Southeast Bahamas* should **avoid** entering waters, due to the **high risk** of rip currents and rough surf. Meanwhile a **moderate** risk is in effect for waters in the Northwest and Central Bahamas. ***Beachgoers are urged to exercise caution when entering the water.***

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Coastal Hazards: Motorists and pedestrians across the **Southeast Bahamas** are advised to exercise caution while traversing **eastern and southern** coastal roads and shorelines due to possible overtopping waves and sea spray, especially during the high tide cycle.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS:	Partly cloudy to cloudy with some overcast periods this afternoon, becoming partly to variably cloudy tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms this afternoon decreasing to 20% by the evening hours.		
WINDS:	Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Partly cloudy to cloudy and hazy with some overcast periods this afternoon, becoming partly to variably cloudy tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	20% chance of showers or an isolated thunderstorm		
WINDS:	East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

PRECIPITATION: 10 to 20% chance of showers.
WINDS: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: A mix of sun, clouds and haze this afternoon, becoming mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 10% chance of showers.
WINDS: East to southeast at 15 to 25 knots with *gusts to near gale force possible*.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern Bahamas:** Partly sunny during the morning hours and a mix of sun and clouds by the afternoon hours, becoming mostly fair at night
Northwest and Central Bahamas: Partly cloudy, becoming mostly fair at night
Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, becoming mostly fair tonight

PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 10 to 20% chance of showers.

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 knots or less.
Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts across the Southeast Bahamas.

Elsewhere: 10 to 20% chance of showers

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 knots or less.
Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts across the Southeast Bahamas.

Central Bahamas: Partly to variably cloudy, becoming mostly fair at night.
Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, variably cloudy at night

PRECIPITATION: **Southeast Bahamas:** 20% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
Elsewhere: 10 to 20% chance of showers

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 knots or less
Northwest and Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts
Southeast Bahamas: East at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts

SKY CONDITIONS: All areas: Partly sunny to sunny and variably cloudy at night

PRECIPITATION: All Areas: 10 to 20% chance of showers and isolated afternoon thunderstorms.
 Northern Bahamas: Variable at 10 knots or less.

WINDS: Northwest Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots.
 Central Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
 Southeast Bahamas: East at 15 to 20 knots

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
 90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C 77°F – 81°F / 25°C – 27°C 100°F – 106°F / 38°C – 41°C

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy.
 Elsewhere: A mix of sun and clouds.

PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
 Elsewhere: 10% chance of showers.

WINDS: Northern Bahamas: South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 knots or less.
 Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less.
 Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots but higher gusts occurring in the Southeast Bahamas.

PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
 Elsewhere: 10% chance of showers.

WINDS: Northern Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
 Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
 Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.
 Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 25 knots.
