



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, SATURDAY, APRIL 11, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

<p><b>WARNING IN EFFECT:</b></p>	<p>A <b>Near Gale Warning (28-33 knots)</b> remains in effect for the Northern, Northwest &amp; Central Bahamas. Occasional gusts to near-gale force are likely across these areas. Boaters, especially small craft operators, are urged to seek safe harbor and remain in port.</p> <p>A <b>Near Gale Watch</b> is in effect for the Southeast Bahamas. Near gale winds gusts are possible across portions of the <b>Southeast Bahamas</b> beginning <b>Sunday afternoon</b>. <p><b>GENERAL SITUATION:</b></p>	<p>Dry and mostly stable conditions will continue across most of the island chain this afternoon under the influence of high pressure ridging, with moderate to strong breezes persisting through tonight, while near-gale force gusts remain confined mainly to the portions of the Northwest and Central Bahamas.</p> <p><b>OUTLOOK:</b> High pressure ridging is expected to continue to build across the island chain producing breezy conditions along with hazardous boating and beaching weather. These fresh to strong breezes will spread across the archipelago and last into next week. Residual moisture along with low level troughing is expected to elevate shower activity over the Southern islands over the next few days, while the remainder of the country will experience more dry and stable conditions.</p>
<p><b>SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:</b></p>	<p><b>Rip Currents and Rough Surf:</b> There is a <b>high risk</b> of rip currents for all Atlantic coastal waters and passages across the entire island chain. Swimmers are advised to refrain from entering these waters and to exercise extreme caution when crossing the Glass Window Bridge on the island of Eleuthera until further notice.</p> <p><b>On shore flooding:</b> There is a moderate to high risk of on shore salt water inundation across the island chain. Wind driven waves and northeast sea swells are expected to drive moderate to large waves onto Atlantic exposed shores.</p>

<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	A mix of sun and clouds, becoming fair tonight.

<b>WINDS:</b>	Northeasterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts this afternoon increasing to 15 to 25 knots tonight with <b>possible gusts to near-gale force</b> .
