BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, SATURDAY, JUNE 27, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

A **Heat Advisory** remains in effect for the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas (inclusive of the islands of **Grand Bahama, Bimini, Abaco and The Berry Islands**). *The public should remain hydrated, limit strenuous outdoor activities and seek shaded areas during peak heat hours.*

A relatively moist airmass remains across the Northern Bahamas supporting isolated showers and a thunderstorm or two over those islands. Hot, hazy and humid conditions is being experienced across the country while a ridge of high pressure and mild to moderate Saharan Dust remains across the area.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: A weak surface trough is expected to move into the Southeast Bahamas on Sunday possibly introducing a few showers across that area as the feature moves westward and weakens through Monday. Around the same time, winds across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas are expected to become light to gentle as the pressure pattern relaxes across the area. By Tuesday, troughing tied to a frontal boundary over the southeastern United States will move into the Northern Bahamas, increasing shower and thunderstorm chances.

Rip Currents: There is a **slight to moderate** risk of rip currents for the Atlantic and east to southeastern coastlines of the Bahamas.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

UV Index: Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high** range.

Elsewhere: A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy at night.**PRECIPITATION:** **Northern Bahamas:** 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.**WINDS:** **Northern Bahamas:** Southeast to south at less than 10 knots, becoming east to southeast at by evening.**Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 knots or less.**Central Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, becoming east-northeast to east-southeast at 10 knots or less by evening.**Southeast Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds**PRECIPITATION:** **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 20 to 40% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers or an isolated thunderstorms**WINDS:** **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, becoming light and variable during the afternoon hours and east-northeast to east-southeast at less than 10 knots by the evening.**Central and Southeast Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts across the Southeast Bahamas.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers or an isolated thunderstorm.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Variable at less than 10 knots.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts across the Southeast Bahamas
