BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, SATURDAY, MAY 30, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

There are no public warnings in effect at this time. For marine warnings and forecast, please visit met.gov.bs.

Generally cloudy conditions will persist across the northern half of the country as scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms shift into the Northwest Bahamas through this evening associated with troughing. Elsewhere, a weak surface ridge supports lower rain chances with more sunshine and gentle to moderate breezes.

GENERAL SITUATION:

OUTLOOK: A weak frontal boundary is anticipated to move into the northern islands tomorrow, maintaining an elevated chance of showers and thunderstorms across the Northern & Northwest Bahamas through the weekend. On Monday, an area of low pressure will emerge off of the U.S. east coast dragging another weak frontal boundary near the Northern Bahamas, introducing an additional round of showers and thunderstorms, mainly across that region. Weak high pressure will keep rain chances low on Monday across the remainder of the country. A significant layer of Saharan dust will move into the Southeast and portions of the Central Bahamas by Tuesday, reducing rain chances over those areas while possibly impacting air quality. Shower and thunderstorm chances increase once again across the Northern & Northwest Bahamas by midweek as another developing low brings a front near the area. Expect a gradual drying trend across the country by Thursday evening into the following weekend.

Thunderstorm Activity: There is a *marginal to moderate* risk for a few isolated strong thunderstorms across portions of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas this afternoon.

Flood Risk: There is a *marginal* risk of flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas across portions of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas, especially during heavy rainfall events.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Heat and UV Index: Residents across **The Central & Southeast Bahamas** are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 3pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the *very high* range and heat indices can reach the *upper 90's*.

Saharan Dust: There is a moderate level of Saharan dust across portions of the Southeast Bahamas, especially the **Turks and Caicos Islands**, which may impact air quality and hinder visibility to some degree. As a result, persons with respiratory issues should take the necessary precautions to safeguard their health.
