



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

**BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, SUNDAY, MARCH 29, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.**

<b>WARNING IN EFFECT:</b>	<i>A <b>Near Gale Warning (28 – 33 knots)</b> is in effect for the entire Bahamas. For additional marine information, please view our marine forecast on our website, <a href="http://met.gov.bs">met.gov.bs</a>.</i>
<b>GENERAL SITUATION:</b>	<p>A cold front will trudge across the northern territories this afternoon, introducing increasing cloudy conditions and showers as the feature advances southward throughout the period. A strengthening wind regime is anticipated in response to the inbound front, with brisk conditions and near gale gusts occurring across all areas by tonight.</p> <p><i><b>Outlook:</b></i> Fresh to strong breezes, with occasional gusts approaching near gale force and rough seas, especially along Atlantic coastlines, will persist through much of the upcoming week. The cold front is expected to sweep through the island chain, exiting the Southeast Bahamas by early Tuesday, after which high pressure will become the dominant weather feature. Meanwhile, Atlantic moisture, driven by the brisk wind flow, will support occasional showers across the archipelago throughout the work week.</p>
<b>SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:</b>	<p><b>Coastal Flooding and Over-Topping Waves:</b> There is a <b>moderate</b> to <b>high</b> risk of overtopping waves along seawalls and coastal roads along Atlantic-exposed shorelines, especially the Glass Window Bridge on the island of Eleuthera beginning today. A <b>marginal</b> risk of coastal flooding is expected across all other northern and eastern-facing coastal roadways. <i><b>Motorists and residents are urged to exercise extreme caution while traversing these areas.</b></i></p> <p><b>Rip Currents:</b> <b>Rough surf conditions and dangerous rip currents</b> will plague the area waters of the island chain beginning today. These conditions are expected to continue until mid-week. <i><b>Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly advised to avoid entering the waters.</b></i></p>
