BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, SUNDAY, MAY 31, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

Moisture associated with an active frontal boundary along the eastern flank of the country will continue to sag southward toward the Northern Islands, with the bulk of shower and thunderstorm activity remaining mainly offshore. Elsewhere, a more stable air mass is beginning to filter across the island chain, while a weak high-pressure pattern supports more isolated shower activity and gentle breezes through this evening.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: A series of low pressure systems will develop off of the coast of the Carolinas and will trek eastwards into the Atlantic. These lows will continue to guide rich tropical moisture across the Bahamas through most of the upcoming week, while producing some choppy sea conditions along the Northern and Atlantic shorelines of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. The southern islands will experience a short period of intense Saharan Dust intrusion between Tuesday and Thursday, bringing about milky skies and reduced air quality. A late season cold front may drift into and weaken across the Northern Bahamas by late Thursday into early Friday morning, nudging most of the moisture southwards and keeping a wet weather pattern across the Central and Southeast Bahamas heading into next weekend.

Saharan Dust: There is a **moderate** level of Saharan dust across the **Southeast Bahamas**, and the Turks and Caicos Islands which may impact air quality and hinder visibility to some degree. Persons with respiratory issues should take the necessary precautions to safeguard their health.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Heat and UV Index: Residents across **The Northwest Bahamas** are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (12pm – 4pm), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high to extreme** range and heat indices can reach the **upper 90's**.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to occasionally cloudy this afternoon through tonight.
30 – 40% chance of isolated to widely scattered showers with a slight chance of an isolated thunderstorm or two through this evening.

PRECIPITATION: 10 - 20% chance of showers late tonight.

WINDS: West to northwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times this afternoon. Expect winds to shift south to southwest at 10 knots or less tonight.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Mix of sun and clouds this afternoon, becoming partly cloudy tonight.
20 – 30% chance of a few isolated showers with one or two isolated thunderstorms this afternoon, mainly over **Andros**.

PRECIPITATION: 10 - 20% chance of isolated showers by this evening.

WINDS: West to northwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times beginning this afternoon through tonight.

SKY CONDITIONS: Mostly cloudy this afternoon, becoming partly cloudy tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 20% chance of a few isolated showers this afternoon, decreasing to a 10% chance by tonight.

WINDS: Southwest to west at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times, veering north to northeast at 10 knots or less this afternoon through tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 20 – 30% chance of isolated showers with a slight chance of an isolated thunderstorm or two this afternoon.
10 – 20% chance of showers by this evening.

WINDS: Variable at 10 knots or less, veering north to northeast at 10 knots or less this afternoon through tonight.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly cloudy by the afternoon hours through to nightfall.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy, turning mostly fair at night.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 20 – 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms, increasing 30 – 50% by nightfall.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** South to southwest at 10 knots or less, veering southwest to west at 10 to 15 knots by the afternoon hours.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.

Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** West to northwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable by nightfall.
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable by the afternoon hours.
