BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EST, SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EST.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	Gale (34-40 knots) watch comes into effect at noon on Monday for the Northern and Northwest Bahamas, and at 6 pm for the Central Bahamas. Additional gale watches/warnings or amendments to existing watches/warnings may be issued during the next scheduled forecast. For upcoming sea conditions, please see our Marine Forecast @ met.gov.bs.
GENERAL SITUATION:	High pressure ridging continues to dominate across the island chain, maintaining light to moderate breezes and only minimal shower activity through tonight ahead of an advancing cold front. Outlook: A prefrontal trough along with a strong cold front will move through the Northern and Northwest Bahamas on Monday, bringing some shower activity with it. By early Tuesday, strong high pressure will build across area behind the front, promoting cooler temperatures and breezy to windy conditions for the week. The front is expected to stall near the Southeast Bahamas producing some showers and thunderstorm activity across the Southeast and portions of the Central Bahamas into Wednesday or Thursday. The stalled boundary will gradually dissipate into the start of the weekend.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Overtopping Waves: Beginning Monday night, motorists and pedestrians on the island of Eleuthera are to exercise extreme caution when crossing the Glass Window Bridge. Rip Currents: Beachgoers and swimmers across all areas are advised to NOT enter all Atlantic exposed beaches as there is a moderate risk of rip currents. The risk of rip currents will become dangerous and life threatening beginning in the Northern Bahamas on Monday. Coastal Flooding: Due to the full moon, residents should be alert for flooding along banks, marshes and coastal areas during high tide.

PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and thunderstorms. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20% chance of showers and 10% chance of thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots ahead of the front west to northwest at 15 to 25 knots behind the front. Winds are expected to freshen Northwest to north at 20 to 25 knots with gusts strong to near gale strength by late night across the area. Central Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 knots or less becoming northwest to north at 15 to 25 knots by nightfall. Southeast Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable by nightfall.
